## PUBLIC CONSULTATION WORKSHOPS ON DRAFT MARKET CONDUCT POLICY FRAMEWORK

National Treasury published the discussion document *"Treating Customers Fairly in the Financial Sector: A Draft Market Conduct Policy Framework for South Africa"* in December 2014. The document sets out a proposed approach to strengthening and improving market conduct regulation for financial institutions in South Africa, to ensure that customers are treated fairly. This is part of the Twin Peaks reform of financial sector regulation. Comments are invited on the document until 8 April.
