Question 23

Specification 1.2 The bed should have the ability to go on full chair position to enable easy patient egress. You also ask for a full-length safety side on this bed. If a bed offers a full chair position we don't provide full length safety side because of the full chair position. Please confirm if you require full chair position with partial safety side to accommodate the full chair position?

Response 23

The confirmation is as follows: There are 2 types of beds that can be submitted as follows:

- 1. Full chair position that can go with half size length safety side, and
- 2. Full length safety side bed that does not need to be a full chair position

Question 24a

The following spec is on item 02-020 and this makes perfect sense. Maybe item 17 and 18 should have been the same?

The height of the mattress support shall be adjustable in the range (minimum 260 to 490) and (highest 500 to 800) mm - measured from the floor to the top of the mattress support.

Response 24a

Your response to your question is correct. Thank you for bringing that up, will update the Questions and Answers accordingly

In addition to the already provided response being the height of the mattress support shall be adjustable in the range (minimum 260 to 490) and (highest 500 to 800) mm - measured from the floor to the top of the mattress support as stated on item RT24-002-020

Additionally, the lowest height should be left as is because it is accommodative with whatever Height but also accommodates Beds that can go lowest so the Patient can simply Roll out of Bed instead of FALLING OFF THE BED. A compromise will be to amend the lowest to 400mm (The height of couch sitting platform), patient will still be able to be in sitting position with feet touching the floor. There are Beds which go very low which are suitable for Patients who need to get out of Bed at a time when there is no Nurse to help them out of Bed especially at night where the staff Shortages are at their worst , so the 260mm is not a mistake it is a deliberate and genuine request. The overall maximum Height should be up to 900 mm (an update to the technical specification will be published to reflect the amendment from 800 to 900 mm)

Any bed going lower than that is a benefit.

We have been awarded the RT24-03-008ME Stainless Steel Male Urinal. It comes up again on this new RT24-1-2021? As per the spec's it is the same item. Please let me know why we have to tender for it again?

Item RT24-003-008 which is a Bedpan with Lid was not awarded. Your company was awarded item RT24-003-005. Please see published Contract Pricing below to validate that item 003-008 was not awarded

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Question 27

With regards to the RT24-1-2021 Supplementary Bid only furniture are requested as per appendix P, L&H, F, G, H and K? All the beds are already awarded? I just want to insure that I am not overlooking an item.

Response 30

It was indicated at the start of the meeting and towards the end when 1 bidder requested about the recording that it will not be published but we will publish the briefing session presentation, questions and answers on the 11th and 15th October 2021.

It is compulsory to submit on both platforms (online) and at the Tender Information Centre. A bidder does not choose where to submit as outlined on section 11 on the special conditions of contract.

Question 31

Can you kindly confirm if the bed extension mattress piece should be included in the price for RT24-02-020ME?

1,23	Extension of bed of at least 25cm must be possible	

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It is specified on items numbers: RT24-02-017ME & RT24-02-018ME

1,20	Extension of bed of at least 25cm must be possible and mattress piece of the extension must be provided with the unit

Could you please advise?

Response 31

Yes, the bed extension mattress price should be included in the price of RT24-02-020 as per section 1,23

Question 32a

If Hospi-Furn wants to bid for RT24-02-017, Electric Hospital Bed, then we must bid on the mattress RT24-02-022 because the items are a series. But, we have already been awarded the mattress on the main bid.

So what should we do in this case?

Response 32a

As your company has already been awarded the mattress on the main bid RT24-2021, therefore your company need not bid for the mattress again but for the other item RT24-02-017. For other bidders who are not awarded either 1 item in a series they must bid for the entire series items

Question 33

- 1. If we fully import a product from an international producer factory with all ISO/CE and European standards, do we still have to prove standards locally? Import samples or provide detailed production standards?
- 2. If we support locally, already approved products, do we still have to submit samples?

Response 33

ISO/CE standards are accepted but you need the ensure that the CE certificate covers PRODUCT PERFORMANCE TESTS and is not a systems certification similar to ISO 9001. PRODUCT PERFORMANCE TESTS is the requirement

Submission of samples is an evaluation Phase that all bidder must adhered to. It goes handin-hand with the test reports. Phase 3 is the local production and content where the evaluation of the items on local content will take place. These phases evaluation will prove if your items are local and will also prove if you have the item tests conducted as per the requirements of the supplementary bid



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Question 34

Is it necessary to return documentation that has no relevance to my organization as a bidder? a) Sub-contractors' documents, I will not be sub-contracting. b) Exchange rate for local production and content. c) Annex C: Local Content Declaration - Summary Schedule. d) Annex D: Imported Content Declaration. e) Annex E: Local Content Declaration - Supporting Schedule to Annex: C. f) Exemption letter by DTIC where raw material or input is not available locally (where applicable). g) Manufacturer's letter declaring the imported content (where applicable). SBD6.2 is not relevant for my organization as I am an importer; I do not manufacture locally?

Response 34

As clearly as outlined during the briefing session that you return documents for the categories bidding for. If you bidding for all categories, you will return document for ALL phases. If you are not bidding for Category 2 and 8, you will return documents for Phase 1, 4 and 5 and NOT Phase 2 and 3

Question 35

Is the accumulative experience of lead personnel in a company profile (the core technical personnel)? This requirement is part of functionality and accounts for 10% weighting points in phase 2. What are about new entrants, especially small new companies? How will these be vetted? Small new companies do not have experience nor references, yet may have the potential to supply a good quality product at a competitive price? How does the BEC expect to see as a satisfactory compliant response from such a bidder.

Response 35

Category 2 and 8 requires the requirements indicated due to the nature of the commodity on these categories. Joint ventures, consortiums and more of such companies are allowed to bid and this is whereas a new entrant you balance your capabilities by being in underwings of established companies to gain such experience that will help a new entrant to be independent in the near future

To gain experience as a new entrant as a start you partner with those who have the experience as it not obtained in any other way

Question 36

What is the difference between TCBD 1 Authorization Declaration and Approval letter indicating the distributor / sub-distributor or re-seller of equipment is approved to supply the hospital furniture by the OEM? Are we required to submit the Approval letter indicating the distributor / sub-distributor or re-seller of equipment is approved to supply the hospital furniture by the OEM on the OEM letterhead? Is there a particular format required on the OEM Approval letter?



Response 36

TCBD 1 has 3 sections (1.1 and 1.2)

TCBD 1 is Authorization Declaration that must be completed when sourcing any goods or services from another party. It goes with:

TCBD 1.1 where you list the goods or services to be offered, and

TCBD 1.2 which is the letter of undertaking\

Question 37

Please clarify "Any local distributors must submit their OEM agreements that will be reviewed by the DTIC for execution." Does this question refer to local OEM or international OEM agreements?

Response 37

If you are sourcing any goods or services from another party, it is an expectation that as a bidder you must be able to offer service and maintenance in addition support to Participants who will procure those items offered. Agreement from OEM can be an overseas or local OEM if you are sourcing any goods from them as we need to know the agreement that will be provided to the bidder by the OEM

Question 38

How do bidders provide evidence of lead personnel OEM training as travel had been restricted since Covid-19, Coronavirus lockdown? Technical training certificate by original equipment manufacturer for lead technical personnel is a functionality requirement which accounts for 20% on "Item Knowledge and Understanding.

Response 38

The provision of training can be in many methods and so is the evidence. It is not only travelling that allows bidders to provide training. We have been having meetings such as the briefing session meeting without travelling as an example and there is evidence of that meeting. It is on the same breath that the requirement can be fulfilled

Question 39

Clause 5.3.1 stipulates "It is a condition of this bid in respect of base, mattress and clothing (mattress cover and any other clothing in this bid) that only locally produced or manufactured base, mattress and clothing with the below stipulated threshold for local production or manufactured will be considered." The delivery bed, delivery bed mattress as well the delivery bed mattress cover are all from the same international OEM supplier and fully imported.



They are in a series. Will the BEC accept imported products for the delivery bed, delivery bed mattress as well the delivery bed mattress cover?

Response 39

It is a requirement by Government (DTIC) that those 3 items be locally manufactured hence they have been designated to support and uplift to the local economy.

Section 5.3.16 of the Special Conditions of Contract states that If the raw material or input to be used for a specific item is not available locally, bidders should obtain written exemption from the DTIC should there be a need to import such raw material or input

Section 5.3.18 of the Special Conditions of Contract states that a copy of the exemption letter must be submitted together with the bid document at the closing date and time of the bid.

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
