- 6.1 Where security is required particulars thereof are indicated in the tender documents. However, security is mostly not required for services with an estimated value of less than R100 000.
7. Regional Offices and the East London sub-office of the Department of Public Works keep lists of Approved Contractors for building services from R5 000 to R500 000 and for electrical and mechanical services from R5 000 to R150 000 in their respective areas. Any contractor interested in tendering for these services should apply to the Regional Representative/Officer in Charge concerned to have his name included in the list for that area.
 - 7.1 The Regional Offices are at Bloemfontein, Cape Town, Durban, Johannesburg, Kimberley, Port Elizabeth and Pretoria. See **Annexure 1** for address list.
 - 7.2 Please note that all documents issued by the Department of Public Works will be sold as follows:
 - R30,00 per set for all services with a pre-estimated value from R30 000 to R300 000.
 - R100,00 per set for all services with a pre-estimated value of R300 000 and above.

These amounts will not be refunded. Only cash, bank guaranteed cheques and postal orders will be accepted.
