APPOINTMENT OF REGIONAL PROFESSIONAL TEAMS

The Gauteng Department of Housing is currently re-aligning the implementation of housing delivery and will in future follow an incremental approach. The approach aims to speed-up access to housing through making available serviced stands to qualifying beneficiaries as the first stage and the construction of top structures through the peoples housing process as the second stage. New projects as well as the upgrading and formalization of settlements will be implemented through the incremental approach and it is envisaged that at least 240 000 stands will be completed in Gauteng over the next four years.

To implement the approach, the Department will appoint six (6) Regional Professional Teams (RPT) to provide professional services for identified housing projects within the predetermined regions. These regions will be based on an even work distribution and in accordance to local authority boundaries.

The RPT will be required to provide professional services during the following project stages:

- Preliminary Planning Stage to determine project feasibility
- Detailed Planning and Design State
- Implementation Stage

The RPT will be a multi-disciplinary professional team consisting of at least, but not limited to, environmental consultants, town planners, land surveyors, urban designers, geotechnical engineers, civil engineers, conveyancers and beneficiary administrators. An experienced project manager should lead the team with whom the Department will enter into an agreement for a period of one year with an option to extent the appointment on an annually basis up to 4 years.

The Department hereby calls for submissions to appoint six Professional Teams. Submissions must include detailed description of all the activities in each of the states linked to time frames. Previous experience in similar projects will be an advantage. Submissions should also include CV's of key personnel per functional area to be allocated to the programme. Preference will be given to applicants with a strong empowerment component in their proposal.
