

REQUEST FOR INFORMATION

The Department of Defence intends to facilitate the establishment of a Public-Private Partnership to enable eligible persons from the Public and Private Sectors in the RSA, who express such a desire, to become empowered, employable and self-sustainable in society at large. Indications are that there are similar requirements in the military elsewhere in Africa, but inter-governmental agreements have not been firmed up to the extent that it can be included in the scope of this Request for information.

One of the cornerstones of the envisaged Public-Private Partnership will be the Service Corps of the Department of Defence, which is presently responsible for skills enhancement and employment assistance to uniformed members and civilian employees, initially during the demobilisation process and later also the military skills development process of the department. As such, the requirement for skills enhancement and employment assistance is of strategic interest to the Department of Defence, in terms of its Human Resource Strategy 2010.

The Service Corps consists of a Head Office with Regional Offices structured to manage its area of responsibility, with a Centre for Advanced Training specialising in technical and entrepreneurial training located at Elandsfontein near Atteridgeville in Pretoria, as well as a Basic Training Facility located at Mankwe in the North West Province, focusing on ABET training in partnership with relevant Government Departments. It is foreseen that these assets will be utilised on a self-sustainable basis by serving a larger market than the Department of Defence, thereby reducing and eventually eliminating the overhead costs to the department.

Foreign donor funding for the technical training of ex-combatants and serving members was obtained and is presently being utilised, as well as funds from the National Skills Development Fund to train the management structure of the Military Veterans Organisations, with specific reference to veterans from previous non-statutory forces. It is foreseen that the terms of reference of these projects will be incorporated in the envisaged Public-Private Partnership, if acceptable to the parties involved.

Information is therefore requested from the Public and Private Sectors to determine the supply and demand factors for the envisaged Public-Private Partnership. Information should in the first instance be structures to identity the interested party, provide contact particulars and also a description of the supply and demand factors identified by the particular interested party or grouping of parties.

The aim of this Request for Information is also to identify potential parties to the envisaged Public-Private Partnership, who will be engaged in appropriate contractual processes in time to come. Therefore, information is also requested on a framework proposal in the form of a business concept and feasibility indicator, seen from the point of view of the potential private partner, as well as an indication of the track record of the potential private partner.
