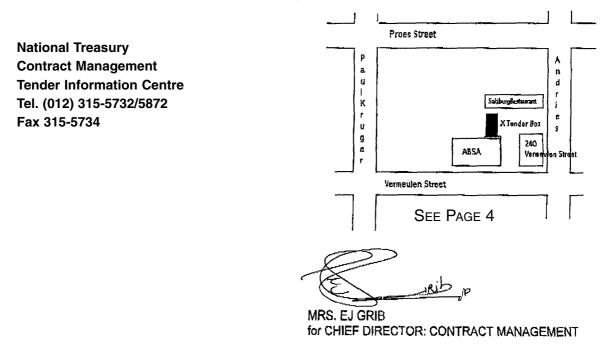

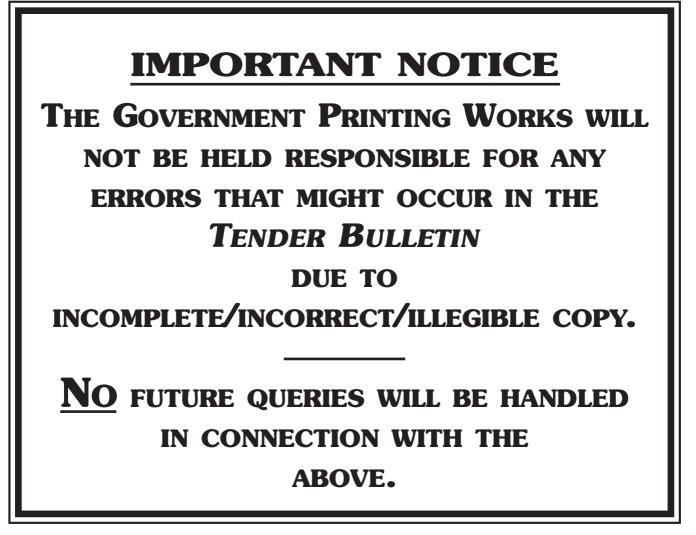

OPSC 004A/2003: BUILDING WORK

1. BUILDING WORK-INTERNAL FIRE ESCAPE DOORS

The internal fire escape doors inside the building that face in the incorrect direction must be changed to face in the direction of the building egress, as indicated on the fire survey. The finish will have to match the existing interior finish inside the building.

2. BUILDING WORK-EXTERNAL FIRE ESCAPE DOOR

The fire escape door in the north-eastern corner must be completed, as per the fire survey. The wall will have to be broken out and a standard fire escape door to be added. The door must be an outward opening door. The finish will have to match the existing exterior finish on the building.

3. BUILDING WORK-CCTV SECURE ROOM

A secure room is to be constructed where the CCTV camera system equipment is to be located. This location will be inside the existing reception area. The existing dry walling will have to be removed and bricked up with double brick walls. A secure solid wooden door must be provided for. Access points must be provided for, for CCTV camera cables. Provision must be made for conducting for additional wall plugs as indicated on the site inspection. The finish will have to match the existing interior finish inside the building.

4. BUILDING WORK-NORTHERN WALL

The northern wall is too low and must be raised to at least 2.1 metres above ground level at all points along the wall. 5. STEEL WORK-STEEL STAIRS

Steel stairs must be installed at the north-eastern corner to allow staff to use the new fire escape door safely, as per the fire survey. (See tender point 2). The width must be sufficient to accommodate a wheelchair. There must be steel railings on either side of a minimum thickness of 50 mm. The stairs and landing must have a minimum thickness of 3 mm. The finish will have to be done in gloss black enamel paint in an acceptable finish.

6. STEEL WORK-STEEL GATE

A steel gate must be installed in the northern perimeter wall to allow staff to safely evacuate the building. (See tender point 2.) This gate must be able to be securely locked from the inside, with provision for a nearby key lockbox. 7. INSTALLATION—ELECTRIC FENCE

An electric fence is to be installed on the northern and eastern perimeters. The energizer must be installed inside the secure CCTV room and a keypad inside the reception area. The energizer must deliver a minimum of 8 000 volt and comply with the legal limits on electric fences. A two-zone energizer is to be used, with each perimeter on a separate zone. All zones are to be wired in series to detect cutting or tampering of the electric fence.

8. INSTALLATION—FIRE ESCAPE STAIRS

The two ground floor fire escape doors on the stairwells leading into the basement parking area must be secured with locks that can only be opened from inside the stairwells. This applies to the north-eastern as well as the south-western stairwells. These locks are to comply with the fire survey specifications and requirements. These locks are to be approved by a fire consultant before acceptance. Provision must be made for these doors are to be alarmed.

9. INSTALLATION—FIRE PROOF MATERIAL IN LIFT SHAFTS

Fire retarding materials are to be installed in all the vertical shaft openings as indicated by the fire survey. This material is to be approved by a fire consultant before acceptance. The material must comply with the relevant SABS fire standards.

10. INSTALLATION—ACCESS CONTROL SYSTEM

A glass access control door must be installed at the reception area, closing off the lifts and adjacent stairs from the reception area and the basement parking areas. This door is to be locked with a magnetic lock with a minimum breaking strength of 450 kg. The access control door must provide enough access for a wheelchair and people with disabilities. An access control system is to be put in place for staff members. The access control system must be computerized with full reporting capabilities, including anti-pass back. Specifications of the proposed access control system must be provided with the tender.

The system must be upgradeable in future. The access control company is to provide proximity access control cards with laminated staff ID photographs on the cards. The company must also make provision for excess cards for additional staff and visitors.

11. INSTALLATION-METAL ROLLER SHUTTER



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
