

1. TOPIC:

This tender is for research services required to assist the Directorate of Employment Standards with the investigation into minimum wages and conditions of employment in the hospitality sector with a view to making a sectoral determination.

2. SUMMARY

- 2.1 Introduction:
- 2.1.1 The Minister has ordered an investigation into the hospitality sector with a view of making a sectoral determination for the sector. In order to establish a sectoral determination for the hospitality sector, the Directorate has identified various processes to be undertaken as part of this investigation. The first phase is the information-gathering phase, which includes research on appropriate wages and conditions of employment for the hospitality sector.
- 2.1.2 In terms of Section 54 (1) and (2) the Director General must submit a report on the findings of the Department of Labour to the ECC for its consideration. The Employment Standards Directorate is responsible for writing the report on behalf of the Director General, Section 54(3) of the BCEA lays down criteria that must be considered by the ECC when advising the Minister on publishing a sectoral determination for a sector or area.
- 2.1.3 Accordingly, in calling for this research, the Directorate proposes that the research be aligned with the criteria to be used by the ECC. This information will be used in the report by the Department of Labour to the ECC about appropriate wages and conditions of employment for the hospitality sector.
- 2.1.4 Subsequent to the research, the ECC and the Department of Labour will embark on various consultative processes within the sector, which will include amongst others, public hearings and workshops with stakeholders. The research report will also inform these processes.

3. Scope of the investigation

- 3.1 The initial terms of reference for the investigation into the hospitality sector were published in the *Government Gazette* of 19 February 1999 under Government Notice No. R205 and were set out as follows:
 - (a) To review the following wage determinations:
 - (i) Wage determination 479: Accommodation Establishment Trade, Certain Areas;
 - (ii) Wage determination 461: Catering Trade, Certain Areas;
 - (iii) Wage determination 457: Hotel Trade, Certain Areas;
- (iv) Wage determination 477: The Trade of Letting of Flats or Rooms, Certain Areas, and to establish the feasibility of grouping them together in a single determination for the Hospitality Sector.
 - (b) To make recommendations regarding the wages and working conditions in South Africa pertaining to this sector.
- 3.2 The terms of reference were subsequently extended to provide a broader definition of the hospitality sector and to extend the scope and application of the investigation to the whole of South Africa. The extended terms of reference were published in *Government Gazette* No. 20968 of 17 March 2000 in Government Notice No. R229 and were set out as follows:

To investigate conditions of employment and the rate of remuneration in respect of all classes of employees in the Hospitality sector in the Republic of South Africa. In the application of these terms of reference, Hospitality Sector, means any business that is associated with the following activities:

- (a) Hotel and restaurants, including hotels, motels, resorts, and game lodges, hotels, guest houses, guest farms and bed and breakfast:
 - (b) provision of short-stay accommodation including short-term rental, self-catering or time shared, camps, caravan parks;
- (c) restaurants: bars, canteens and other catering services including food preparation, food and beverage services. Licensed clubs and fine dining establishments; pubs and taverns, fast food outlets, snack bars and kiosks, industrial and contract caterers; functions and outside careers;
- (d) travel agencies, tour operators and related activities, including retail and general travel operations; marketing and development agencies and companies, tourism authorities, commissions and boards, tourist information centres; tourism industry associations;
- (e) destination management including tour operators and guides; venue management; museums; special attractions, management of special events, conventions, exhibitions and festivals: events, conferences, festival and attraction venue management; fun fairs and parks rafting; abseiling; hang-gliding, bungee-jumping and other adventure tourism operations;
 - (f) motor car rental services;
- (g) conservation: games parks and zoological establishments including wildlife conservation, wildlife parks and game reserves; camp and conservation park management; trekking and safari operators; botanical gardens.
- (h) gaming and gambling including casinos and other tables, electronic and slot machine gaming outlets; clubs, gambling, betting and booking operators; totalisators; lottery operations, horse racing clubs; and
 - (i) inbound international airline operators.

4. REASONS FOR INVESTIGATING THE SECTOR

4.1 Wage levels

- 4.1.1 There are currently four wage determinations regulating conditions of employment and wages within the hospitality sector. Notwithstanding the recent changes in the employment conditions as contained in the BCEA, employees within the hospitality sector have to contend with outdated wage levels. The wage levels in the most of these wage determinations have not been revised in more than seven years and the conditions of employment for almost ten years.
- 4.1.2 The wage levels as contained in the present wage determinations make it difficult for employees to negotiate a living wage as these are seldom adjusted to take into account the cost of living and other factors.

4.2 Geographical demarcation

- 4.2.1 The collapse of the Industrial Councils in the major centers in the past few years and the creation and demarcation of new municipal boundaries and the magisterial districts throughout the country have created confusion within the hospitality sector. The geographical areas reflected in the present wage determinations are not aligned to the new demarcation model introduced by the National Demarcation Board.
- 4.2.2 The new demarcation model introduced by the National Demarcation Board and areas reflected in the present wage determinations are not aligned. This creates disputes and contribute towards enforcement problems since it is not clear which wage rates are applicable to various geographical areas.

4.3 Single determination for four sub-sectors

- 4.3.1 There are presently four wage determinations that cover employers and employees within the hospitality sector, namely:
 - Wage determination 479: Accommodation Establishment Trade, Certain Areas;
 - Wage determination 461: Catering Trade, Certain Areas;
 - Wage determination 457: Hotel Trade, Certain Areas;
 - Wage determination 477: The Trade of Letting of Flats or Rooms, Certain Areas.
- 4.3.2 The research team will also have to establish the feasibility of grouping the above-mentioned determinations into a single sectoral determination for the hospitality sector.

4.4 Vulnerability of workers

- 4.4.1 The common practice in the most sectors is to use negotiations to determine the wages. However, this is done at larger employers where there is unionization or workplace forums in place. Wage increases are negotiated at these levels and the wage determinations are not regarded as useful because of the outdated figures.
- 4.4.2 While there is evidence of unionization and collective bargaining in the some of the sub-sectors within the hospitality sector, a sectoral determination is necessary to protect employees at smaller concerns or those who are unorganized.
- 4.4.3 Accordingly it is necessary that research be conducted into the sector to determine the levels of vulnerability of workers within this sector.

5. TASKS THAT THE TENDERER WILL BE REQUIRED TO CARRY OUT

 - (a) Wage determination 479: Accommodation Establishment Trade, Certain Areas;
 - (b) Wage determination 461: Catering Trade, Certain Areas;
 - (c) Wage determination 457: Hotel Trade, Certain Areas;
 - (d) Wage determination 477: The Trade of Letting of Flats or Rooms, Certain Areas.
