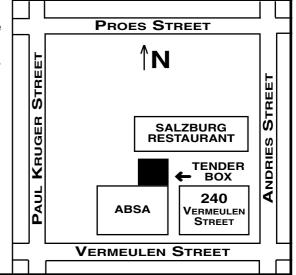

1.1 In reference to the following Pricing Schedule form item and relevant description:

RT 57-01-27 CV: Four/five seater Sedan 4 door, high performance engine with piston displacement 1 600 cm³/110 kW (petrol).

The item description is adjusted to read as follows:
