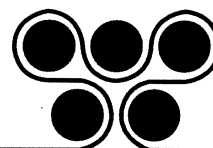

2. **FORM No. 2:** Complete this form together with Form No. 1, when you advertise for the first time, to receive your own tender address list number.

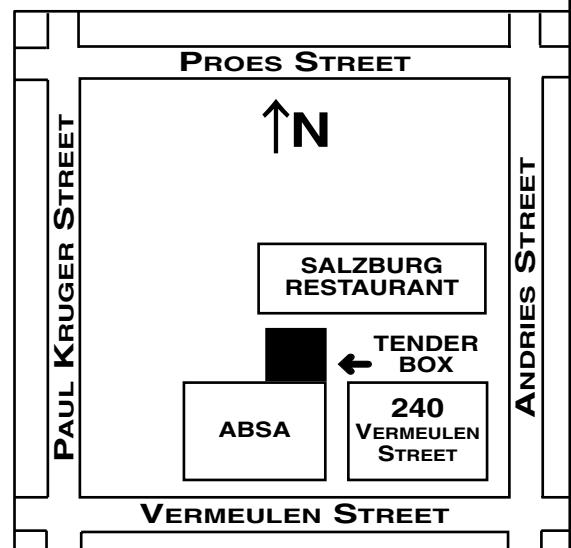
