## CONTRACT RT69-2019: SUPPLY, DELIVERY, FITMENT AND BALANCING OF TYRES AND TUBES TO THE STATE FOR THE PERIOD 1 NOVEMBER 2019 TO 31 OCTOBER 2022.

- 1. This contract will be subject to the General Conditions of Contract issued in accordance with Chapter 16A of the Treasury Regulations published in terms of the Public Finance Management Act, 1999 (Act 1of 1999). The Special Conditions of Contract are supplementary to that of the General Conditions of Contract. Where, however, the Special Conditions of Contract are in conflict with the General Conditions of Contract, the Special Conditions of Contract will prevail.
- 2. The contract circular for the aforementioned contract distributed to user departments by the National Treasury, constitutes the official pricing and binding supply agreement between the contractor and the State. End-user institutions are, therefore prohibited from making any amendments of any nature to the aforementioned contract.
- The National Treasury will communicate all amendments, if any, to the user institutions.
  It would only be at the receipt of such notification from the National Treasury that user institutions can affect any changes to this contract.

## 7. Particulars of offers accepted

- 7.1. Particulars of all the offers accepted are reflected in the attached Contract Circular
- 7.2. The details contained in the Contract Circular are all the necessary information to enable ordering officials to place orders. Further technical detail must be obtained from contractors directly and is available on soft copy as well.

## 8. Comparative positioning of accepted offers

- 8.1. The prices reflected in the contract summary report and the comparative ranking have already been determined.
- 8.2. Orders must be placed in accordance with the accepted policy which inter alia means that orders must first be placed with contractors who are ranked highest on points to lowest on points (top to bottom) in the approved comparative order for each line item. It is however necessary to read the Special Conditions of Contract (SCC) very carefully

(especially where the established ranking order is discarded) and apply its contents.

9. Placing of orders.

9.1. Orders should only be placed after written consultation with the cheapest contractor for

a particular line item number on the contract circular that vehicles are available. If such

tyre has already been allocated elsewhere, ordering officials must approach the second

contractor or others on the same basis.

9.2. More expensive tyres should only be ordered after written confirmation has been obtained

from the higher contractor that delivery cannot be affected within the contract period or

that tyres are not available.

9.3. The documents concerning these consultations (letters, facsimile messages, e-mails and

other notes) must be kept for future reference and auditing purposes.

10. Payment conditions (General Purpose)

10.1. Payment must be affected within 30 days from date of invoice, which inter alia is the

delivery date of the vehicle, proved by a signed delivery note.

10.2. End users must ensure that deliveries are executed within the indicated delivery period

reflected. When deliveries are executed outside the stated period, the relevant contractor

is not entitled to any price escalations for those exceptions.

10.3. End users are advised not to delay accepting delivery of tyres from the relevant

contractors in order to delay payments.

11. Delivery periods are stated in the specific contractor's contract documents. Electronic soft

copies of contact documents may also be requested from contractors.

12. End users must not settle invoices with amended prices before an amendment in that

regard has been issued by National Treasury.

13. End users must ensure that details of all performance measures for which they are

responsible must be handed in on time.
