# STRATEGIC SOURCING OF MOTOR VEHICLES - REQUEST FOR ESTIMATES

This instruction is applicable to all national and provincial departments. All Accounting Officers and Heads of Provincial Treasuries are required to disseminate the contents of this instruction within the departments that fall under their jurisdiction.

As part of the drive to improve financial management within government and pursuant to the provisions of section 76(4)(c) of the Public Finance Management Act, 1999 (Act No. 1 of 1999 as amended by Act 29 of 1999), a Regulatory Framework for Supply Chain Management was promulgated on 5 December 2003 in the Government Gazette.

To this end, it is required of accounting officers to implement a Supply Chain Management function that would form an integral part of their financial management system. Furthermore, National Treasury – Specialist Functions has embarked on a Strategic Sourcing Initiative in support of the Supply Chain Management Framework. Part of the process is prudent planning against the available budget.

Past experience has shown that a number of departments have a tendency to invite bids or place orders for goods or services near the end of the financial year in order to spend unused funds in their budgets. This practice places extreme pressure on both suppliers and supply chain practitioners. It also, does not reflect prudent planning and in fact is an indication that unspent funds drive the needs.

In order to help the National Treasury's Strategic Sourcing Project team improve the management of the transversal term contract for the supply and delivery of motor vehicles, you are kindly requested to forward to the National Treasury, by no later than 15 September 2004, a schedule indicating details of the number of motor vehicles your department or the provincial departments falling under your jurisdiction envisage

purchasing during the 2005/2006 financial year, as well as the months in which orders will be placed with the relevant suppliers. Please refer to the attached template.
