

## **FAQ's**

### **Where can I get the tender/bid documents?**

You can get the tender/bid documents from the Tender Information Centre (TIC) or download bid from [www.globalerfx.com](http://www.globalerfx.com).

### **Where can I get a list of available bids/tenders?**

You can get it from the National Treasury website on [www.treasury.gov.za](http://www.treasury.gov.za) or you can subscribe to receive the government tender bulletin electronically or under the tender bulletin folder on this website.

### **How much is the tender/bid document?**

It is free, you need to either collect it from the Tender Information Centre or download bid from [www.globalerfx.com](http://www.globalerfx.com).

### **Question: Where can I get a list of currently available bids/tenders?**

Answer: Look under the available tenders/bids on this website or you can also look in the government tender bulletin.

### **Question: Has this contract been extended?**

Answer: To find out if a contract has been extended you can either look under the Contracts folder on this website or contact the relevant Contract Manager.

### **Question: How do I register for electronic bidding or download a tender/bid?**

Answer: Potential bidders are encouraged to bid electronically, please visit the following website [www.globalerfx.com](http://www.globalerfx.com) to register.

### **What do I do as a local authority to participate in the governmental transversal contracts?**

You need to write a letter to the Chief Director: Contract Management outlining your interest to participate in the transversal contract/s as well as the estimated proposed spend the contract for the contract period
