Selected expenditure trends for the first half of the 2006/07 financial year

Current expenditure has increased (mostly under goods and services) partly because of new projects and increases in the use of contractors where posts are vacant, telephone and travel expenditure, and logistical facilities for members.

The increase in transfers to non-profit institutions is as a result of increased financial support to constituency offices and political parties.

The decrease in payments for capital assets is because less machinery and equipment was purchased due to vacant posts.
