What (a) total amount has the Government appropriated for drought relief measures in each financial year since 1 April 2016, (b) is the detailed breakdown of how the drought relief appropriations were allocated in each case, (c) drought relief measures were funded in each case and (d) monitoring mechanisms did the National Treasury implement to monitor that the appropriated funds were utilised for the intended drought relief in each case?

REPLY:

(a) and (b) Appropriations for drought between 2016/17 and 2020/21 was R6.4 billion. Table 1 below sets out the amounts per province per year.

- (c) Appropriations for drought was mostly in the water sector for boreholes, water tankers and augmentation schemes, and in the agriculture sector for animal feed.
- (d) The oversight and monitoring framework for spending on drought relief is governed by the annual Division of Revenue Act, as the funding is allocated through conditional grants. Reports on spending in relation to the grants are submitted by the accounting officers responsible for the grants to the National Treasury in terms of section 10 of the Division of Revenue Act.
