REPLY

- (1) In terms of the Eskom section 41 report of the MFMA as at the end of September 2022, there are 7 metros that showed overdue balances. These overdue balances range from just over two hundred thousand to marginally over one billion and three hundred million.
- (2) According to the section 41 report, Eskom indicates that they have engaged with the respective metros, reminders were issued for the overdue amounts, a few of the metros have made arrangements to settle the outstanding amounts whilst a few raised disputes with the account. Below is the detail of the status of the accounts with Eskom as at the end of September 2022.

BUFFALO CITY METROPOLITAN MUNICIPALITY	The municipality's account payments are up to date.
NELSON MANDELA BAY METROPOLITAN MUNICIPALITY	Municipality raised dispute regarding the interest payment.
MANGAUNG METROPOLITAN MUNICIPALITY	The municipality signed a payment arrangement
CITY OF EKURHULENI METROPOLITAN MUNICIPALITY	Municipality committed to settle the outstanding balance
