NT012-2025: APPOINTMENT OF SERVICE PROVIDER(S) FOR THE ONCE-OFF SUPPLY, DELIVERY, OFF LOAD AND INSTALLATION OF OFFICE FURNITURE AND SOFT FURNISHINGS AT THE NATIONAL TREASURY OFFICES

	QUESTIONS	ANSWERS
1.	Can multiple documents be uploaded on the eTenders portal	Bidders must follow the instructions on the system. Each folder accepts only one file. If multiple documents are required, please scan and upload them as one combined document in the appropriate folder.
2.	Drawings	We are not in a position to issue soft copies (DWG/Revit files). All tenders and manufacturing coordination must proceed based on the issued PDF drawings and provided dimensions, which remain the official reference documents for this project.
3.	Fabric Costing	For consistency across all furniture and upholstery items, please apply a rate of R350 per metre for fabrics. This will serve as the standard reference rate for tender and costing purposes.
4.	Corporate Connectors, Cabling & Cable Trays	These items do not fall within the furniture supplier's scope. Only the cut-outs for power and data connectors are to be accommodated, and these will be confirmed at the shop drawing approval stage. The supply and installation of corporate connectors, cabling, and trays will be undertaken by the appointed technical consultants.
5.	Finishes	All veneer finishes will be walnut for consistency. This will be confirmed during the shop drawing approval stage. The finishes indicated represent the design intent and should guide suppliers in maintaining visual alignment, durability, and quality consistent with the approved look and feel.
6.	Submittals and Approvals (TOR Point 2.2)	We would like to reiterate point 2.2 of the Terms of Reference, especially given the number of requests received. The recommended suppliers must provide physical samples and/or shop drawings of all proposed furniture items for approval by National Treasury prior to manufacturing. National Treasury reserves the right to verify and confirm final specifications, finishes, and fabric selections before production. Reasonable adjustments to colours, finishes, and fabrics may be made within the agreed pricing

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		to ensure alignment with the overall design intent.



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
