## MEDIA ADVISORY PRE-WORLD ECONOMIC FORUM BREAKFAST

Media are invited to attend a pre-World Economic Forum (WEF) breakfast on **16 January 2020**. The meeting serves as a preparatory engagement for Team SA ahead of their departure to Davos, Switzerland, for WEF's 50<sup>th</sup> annual meeting.

The breakfast will be led by the Minister of Finance, Tito Mboweni, and will comprise of government Ministers and SA business leaders. The pre-WEF breakfast allows government and business to engage on the South Africa message they wish to take to Davos.

The 2020 WEF Davos annual meeting will be convened under the theme: “**Stakeholders for a Cohesive and Sustainable World**”, and will run between the 21<sup>st</sup> and 24<sup>th</sup> of January. The Minister of Finance, Tito Mboweni; Minister of International Relations and Cooperation, Naledi Pandor; and Minister of Trade and Industry, Ebrahim Patel, are scheduled to represent the South African government at the WEF Davos meeting.
