SMART TAXATION: RAISING REVENUE AND REDUCING INEQUALITY IN SOUTH AFRICA

Members of the media are invited to attend the third in a series of the <u>Southern Africa Towards</u> <u>Inclusive Economic Development</u> (SA-TIED) programme policy dialogues titled "**Smart Taxation**: **Raising Revenue and Reducing Inequality in South Africa.**" This policy dialogue will explore potential reforms to the Personal Income Tax (PIT) system, focusing on enhancing its effectiveness in revenue collection and income redistribution.
