It is envisaged however, that this database will contribute to efficient administration and compliance with the PFMA.

It is imperative that suppliers read the application document carefully, complete it in full and sign it. Please note that an original valid Tax Clearance Certificate must be attached. Terminology:

<u>Previously Disadvantaged Individuals (PDI)</u>: For the purpose of registering as a supplier for CBDA, the refutable presumption shall be made that SA citizens who fall into population groups that had no franchise in national elections prior to the introduction of the 1983 and 1993 constitution are Previously Disadvantaged Individuals. It is incumbent on individuals to demonstrate their claims to fall into such population groups on the basis of identification and association with and recognition by the members of such a group.

Women: A female person who is a SA citizen.

Establishment of PDI / Women Equity Ownership in a enterprise: Equity ownership shall be equated to the percentage of an enterprise which is owned by individuals, or in the case of a company, the percentage shares that are owned by individuals who are actively involved in the management and daily business operations of the enterprise and exercise control over the enterprise, commensurate with their degree of ownership.

Where individuals are not actively involved in the management and daily business operations and do not exercise control over the enterprise commensurate with their degree of ownership, equity ownership may not be claimed.
