

## RT81-01-2024: SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF BUILDING MATERIAL TO THE STATE FOR THE PERIOD ENDING 30 APRIL 2027

#	Questions	Answers
1	Is Local content not cancelled by National Treasury?	Local content is not cancelled. All those items which are designated, they are still designated. Each department has its own policy; we can still issue a tender with local content.
2	For the authorization letter, do we have to list all the line items or we can list per category?	On TCD 13.1 you can list according to your authorization letter. You don't have to list all items however the brands must be indicated. All information must be available on the pricing schedule. Let's say you have 3 suppliers that are supplying you, you can put 3 suppliers on the TCD 13.1, but on TCD 13.2 we need to know all the brands.
3	Are we allowed to quote with the minimum order quantity here?	Yes, you must stipulate your minimum order quantity.
4	on the special conditions of contract, it states that the pricing should be done per province, but in terms of the pricing	The price schedule will be amended to reflect the provinces.



	schedule, there's no indication there per province. So how do we do that one?	
5	Can bidders price only items they can supply, or are they forced to price everything as per the price schedule?	Bidders are allowed to price for what they would want to offer. You can select what you would be able to supply.
6	Is RT81-01-2024 a two-year contract?	RT81-01-2024 will be for the period ending 30 April 2027.
7	Is RT81-01-2024 a new contract?	No, RT81-01-2024 is a supplementary bid.
8	If we are an existing supplier on the main contract, and we don't submit a bid this time around, what happens to that?  Are we still going to be listed as suppliers for the main contract?	The main contract is still in existence. The reason Transversal Contracting is going on supplementary is because most of the suppliers are not able to supply on that contract, that is why we are having a supplementary bid. The main contract will still be there. If you are still able to supply with those prices, you can supply with those prices.
9	How many service providers will be awarded for RT81-01-2024?	Transversal Contracting tenders are evaluated per line item, so it will depend who's the highest scoring in terms of the line items, whether it will be one or two per line item, it will depend on the BEC when they're evaluating.



10	How to identify the items that are earmarked for local content?	The items are mentioned on paragraph 6.5.5 of the special condition of contract.
11	What happens if the service provider is unable to deliver based on the end users ordering a single item somewhere very far and it's not feasible to deliver to that place?	The orders by the end users are as and when, there is no guaranteed volumes, so if they order one item, the service provider must deliver that one item.  On the price, we clearly indicate that the price must include delivery cost and VAT. So, when bidders are pricing, they must also consider that the whole country will be ordering from the tender. Bidders can select the province they want to supply and price accordingly.  If it happens that you do not deliver, and it's a multiple award, the end user will go to the next in line and the contract management team will also contact you, but if you still insist that you will able to deliver, the service provider will not be removed unless they indicate that they won't be able to deliver, then we can remove the service provider from the list on that particular line item.
12	Is SAPS the only end user for RT81-01-2024?	No, there are other participating institutions on RT81-01-2024, please refer to paragraph 10 of the special condition of contract.
