RT67-2024: SUPPLY AND DELIVERY OF LIQUID CHLORINE GAS TO THE STATE FOR A PERIOD OF SIXTY (60) MONTHS.

NO	QUESTIONS	ANSWERS
1.	Can you please provide the quantities per participating institution as it will assist with preparing the proposal?	We will request the estimated quantities from the participating institutions. The information will be published on National Treasury website (https://www.treasury.gov.za/divisions/ocpo/ostb/CurrentTenders.aspx) and the eTender portal (https://www.etenders.gov.za/).

2.	In terms of pricing, how should we quote if it is Country-wide.	Bidders must ensure that their pricing is an all-inclusive price to supply and deliver the Liquid Chlorine Gas Country-wide (Nationally). The estimated quantities for each participating institution will be made available to assist in this regard.
3.	It is noted on the pricing schedule and the Special Conditions of Contract that pricing must include any other related cost such as transport, "equipment" etc can you please clarify what is meant by "equipment"?	This tender is for the Supply and Delivery of Chlorine Gas only. The word "equipment" used in this context relates to the actual cylinders and their covers, caps etc.
4.	Is it correct to say that item 1 on the pricing schedule is linked to the first institution on the list example Item 1 on the pricing schedule is for Magalies Water?	No. Orders will be placed by participating institutions on any of the items listed on the pricing schedule. Orders will be placed as and when required. In line with paragraph 14.2.1 of the Special Conditions of Contract, "No quantities are reflected in this bid, as orders will be placed <u>"as and when required"</u> and no guarantee is given or implied as to the actual quantity/quantities that will be procured during the transversal contract period". However, we will publish estimated quantities to assist bidders with preparing their proposals.
5.	In terms of the Mandatory Compliance Certificates such as the Latest Valid NSF/ANSI 60 Standard Certificate, Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS) and Latest Valid ISO 9001 Quality	All bidders must submit the compliance certificates as reflected under paragraph 5.3.4 of the Special Conditions of Contract i.e Latest Valid NSF/ANSI 60 Standard Certificate, Material Safety Data Sheet (MSDS), and the Latest Valid ISO 9001 Quality Management System Compliance Certificate.

Management Certificate.	System Compliance	
Should these certificates be in the name of the bidding company or the manufacturer?	If a bidder is sourcing the goods from a 3 rd party (Manufacturer), these compliance certificates should be in the name of the manufacturer. Therefore, the bidding company that is sourcing from the manufacturer must obtain the Letter of Undertaking (template provided as TCD 13.2) to obtain these Mandatory compliance certificates.	
6. We are aware of some municipalities that have gone out on tender for the same requirement, what is going to happen with their tender that was published?	Bidders will have to follow up with those institutions, as the National Treasury will not be able to respond on behalf of other institutions.	
7. We as a company would buy the chlorine gas from the manufacturers and then pack it and price it to the market, is it correct to say that we as the company are manufacturers?	No, your company does not make/manufacture Chlorine Gas and therefore your company is not a Manufacturer.
