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### **AMENDMENT 26: CONTRACT EXTENSION**

CONTRACT RT3-2022: SUPPLY, DELIVERY, INSTALLATION, COMMISSIONING AND MAINTENANCE OF OFFICE AUTOMATION SOLUTIONS TO THE STATE FOR THE PERIOD ENDING 31 MARCH 2027

# 1. Purpose of the Addendum

- 1.1. This addendum serves to formally record the extension of the RT3-2022 transversal contract for a period of twelve (12) months, from 1 April 2026 to 31 March 2027, under the same terms and conditions. Furthermore, this addendum introduces provisions for price adjustments applicable during and beyond the extended contract period, ensuring clarity and consistency in cost management for participating institutions.
- 2.1. The RT3-2022 transversal contract for the supply, delivery, installation, commissioning, and maintenance of office automation solutions to the State, which was originally set to expire on 31 March 2026, is hereby extended for a further twelve (12) months, from 1 April 2026 to 31 March 2027 under the same terms and conditions.

### 3. Amendment to Lease Extension Limitations

- 3.1. In terms of Paragraph 10 of the Special Conditions of Contract, lease agreements under the RT3-2022 transversal contract were previously subject to staggered extension periods based on the year in which the lease commenced, with some leases not qualifying for any extension beyond the initial 36-month period. This structure created limitations for participating institutions whose lease agreements commenced in the later years of the contract.
- 3.2. In response to a submission made to the Bid Adjudication Committee (BAC), approval has been granted to remove the previously applied staggered lease extension limitations. As a result, all lease agreements concluded under the RT3-2022 transversal contract may now be extended for a period of up to twenty-four (24) months in addition to the minimum thirty-six (36) months initial lease period, irrespective of the date on which the Service Level Agreement (SLA) was entered into. This amendment ensures uniform and equitable access to the lease extension benefit for all participating institutions.

3.3. The extension period of up to 24 months shall be subject to a zero percent (0%) monthly lease cost, meaning that the monthly lease payments during the extension period will be zero rands (R0.00). Only the cost per copy (usage) will be charged during this period, which includes support and maintenance services provided by the service provider.

#### 4. **Price Adjustment Clause**

- 4.1. The following provisions apply to price adjustments under the RT3-2022 contract:
  - 1. The 7th price adjustment has been implemented to effective 10 November 2025.
  - 2. The 8th and final price adjustment under National Treasury administration will be implemented to be effective 1 June 2026.
  - 3. No further price adjustments will be processed by National Treasury beyond 1 June 2026.
- 4.2. Upon expiry of the RT3-2022 transversal contract, price adjustments may be reviewed annually every thirteenth (13th) month following either the implementation date of the last approved price adjustment or the commencement date of the Service Level Agreement (SLA) between the service provider and the participating institution whichever is later.
- 4.3. These adjustments shall be based solely on the annual inflation rate as published by Statistics South Africa or the South African Reserve Bank (yearly average).
- 4.4. The service provider is required to notify and engage with the participating institution(s) regarding any proposed adjustments to copy charges prior to the effective date of implementation. All such proposals must be supported by appropriate documentary evidence substantiating the basis for the adjustment.
