**DEMAND SIDE MANAGEMENT LEVY (DSML) ON 95 UNLEADED PETROL**

A Demand Side Management Levy will be applicable on 95 Unleaded Petrol consumed in the inland area. The initial DSML will be 10,0 cpl and will be adjusted up-or downwards in line with the DSML Rules. **SINGLE MAXIMUM NATIONAL RETAIL PRICE FOR ILLUMINATING PARAFFIN**

The Minister of Minerals and Energy has approved the implementation of a Single Maximum National Retail Price for Illuminating Paraffin with effect 02 April 2003.  
The Single Maximum National Retail Price for Illuminating Paraffin will change on a monthly basis from the first Wednesday of each month and will also be promulgated in the Government Gazette.  
The Single Maximum National Retail Price for Illuminating Paraffin will change from 1006cpl to 1014cpl effective 1 July 2015 meaning an increase of 8cpl
