#### **Expenditure trends**

Total expenditure in 2022/23 was R3.8 billion, 126.6 per cent of the 2022/23 adjusted appropriation. Midyear expenditure in 2022/23 was R2.2 billion, 73.9 per cent of the adjusted appropriation, whereas expenditure for the first half of 2023/24 was R1.4 billion, 52.6 per cent of the adjusted appropriation of R2.6 billion for the year. Compared to the first half of 2022/23, expenditure over the same period in 2023/24 decreased by R824.9 million, 37.2 per cent, mainly due to the conclusion of the Census project in 2022/23.

#### **Revenue trends**

Mid-year revenue in 2022/23 was R1.9 million, 78.9 per cent of the 2022/23 adjusted estimate, whereas mid-year revenue in 2023/24 was R828 000, 71.8 per cent of the adjusted estimates for the year. Compared to the first half of the 2022/23, revenue over the same period in 2023/24 decreased by R1.1 million, 56.3 per cent. This was mainly due to a decrease in the recovery of debt and credit notes from previous financial years.
