Progress

The mid-year target for the number of people actively participating in organised sport and active recreation events was higher than anticipated as a result of events linked to Youth Day and Freedom Day celebrations being held in some provinces. Expenditure trends

Total expenditure in 2022/23 was R6.2 billion, 98.9 per cent of the adjusted appropriation for the year. Midyear expenditure in 2022/23 was R2.8 billion, 44.1 per cent of the adjusted appropriation, whereas expenditure in the first half of 2023/24 was R3.1 billion, 50.2 per cent of the adjusted appropriation of R6.1 billion. Compared to the first half of 2022/23, expenditure over the same period in 2023/24 increased by R274.6 million, 9.9 per cent. This was mainly due to increased spending on transfers and subsidies to public entities, Mzansi golden economy beneficiaries, heritage legacy projects and compensation of employees following the implementation of the 2023/24 wage agreement.

Revenue trends

Mid-year revenue in 2022/23 was R517 000, 46.1 per cent of the adjusted estimate, whereas revenue for the first half of 2023/24 was R6.6 million, 60 per cent of the adjusted estimate of R11.1 million. Compared to the first half of 2022/23, revenue over the same period in 2023/24 increased by R6.1 million, 1 183.6 per cent. This was mainly due to an increase income from the sale of capital assets and the receipt of outstanding revenue from the previous financial year.
