AIM: To support and co-ordinate health programmes by provincial and local authorities in supplying a caring and effective health service in the RSA

PROGRAMME DESCRIPTION:

National health systems

- ensure a functional health system at national, provincial and district level
- liaise with the international health community on health related issues and identify resources to support the development and deployment of health services in the RSA
- co-ordinate regional health co-operation with member states of the SA Development Community (SADC)

Facilities planning and hospital services

- develop policy for the provision and management of hospital services, health technology, radiation control and emergency medical services, manage funding for specialised and highly specialised services as well as for service costs associated with training and research, co-ordinate and fund the planning, building and upgrading of hospitals and other health facilities as well as provide medical advice to other government departments

Human resources

- improve the health status of the people of the RSA in collaboration with relevant stakeholders through the development of policies, norms and standards, capacity building initiatives nationally and provincially, ensuring equitable allocation of interns and community service doctors, maintaining a national human resource plan, maintaining sound relations with health professions and administering medical schemes in compliance with the Medical Schemes Act in order to obtain the optimal management of human resources within the framework of a caring and compassionate ethos

control medicines and related substances, provide professional, administrative and secretarial support to the Medicines Control Council (MCC), control medical devices and regulate cosmetics

Disease prevention and control

development of policy on disease management and control regarding high priority chronic diseases, eye care, cancers and diseases of older persons as well as on the prevention of disabilities, medical rehabilitation and provision of assistive devices

financial assistance to the SA National Council for the Blind

promote the control and prevention of communicable diseases in public health interest including training and financial assistance to organisations in this regard

refund of approved costs incurred by the SA National Tuberculosis Association (SANTA) for the erection and equipping of institutions for persons suffering or suspected to be suffering from communicable forms of tuberculosis

production and filling of vaccines for the prevention of communicable diseases including training in this regard

render virological services at national and international level, including diagnostic services, surveillance, teaching, training and research

Priority service delivery areas

reduce the transmission of HIV infections by communicating and promoting health-seeking behaviour through collaborative efforts with all levels of government and outside government as well as provide appropriate care, counselling and support for those people infected and affected

provide financial assistance to institutions conducting research and disease surveillance i.r.o. HIV/AIDS and sexually transmitted diseases and to non-governmental organisations involved in combating HIV/AIDS

implementation and funding of projects on national, provincial and local level in order to promote the awareness and prevention of AIDS

identify objectives and formulate indicators, policy and programmes for monitoring, prevention and treatment of mental health and substance abuse in the community context

financial assistance to organisations for the promotion of mental health

initiate, co-ordinate and evaluate the prevention and control of tuberculosis, facilitate the provision of communication, health education and information services regarding tuberculosis, payment of contributions, expenses and grants-in-aid regarding organisations, persons and activities which are relevant to the prevention and control of tuberculosis and ensure a monitoring system which is fully functional in all districts

promote and facilitate operational research on tuberculosis and refund approved costs incurred by the SA National Tuberculosis Association (SANTA) for the erection and equipping of institutions for persons suffering or suspected to be suffering from communicable forms of tuberculosis
