1. OVERVIEW

Statement by the Speaker

The Legislature derives its mandate from the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, Act 108 of 1996. The North West Provincial Legislature operates in terms of the Legislature Service Act no. 8 of 1997. It is autonomous and operates differently from other Departments. As the Executing Authority, I shall make sure that administration implements the budget.

Statement by the Acting Accounting Authority

As the Acting Head of Administration, I shall make sure that we implement the budget. The implementation will be done by carrying out the following activities:

- Creating awareness on the part of organs of state on how the Legislature runs its business;
- Building capacity for Members of the Legislature:
- Providing administrative services to Members of the Provincial Legislature to enable them to fulfil
 constitutional functions;
- Involving members of the public in the activities of the Legislature.

Vision

The Legislature of the North West Province is the servant and forum of the people, an agent of change, producing transformatory legislation efficiently, exercising oversight effectively, and deepening the culture of participatory democracy.

Mission

- To promote public participation and civil involvement in the legislative and oversight efficiency.
- To conduct the business of the North West Legislature in an open and transparent manner.
- To establish and maintain a skilled administration that can maximize legislative and oversight efficiency.
- To develop and implement an effective accountability and oversight plan.
- To empower Members of the Legislature in capacity development in various fields.
- To pass transformation driven legislation.
- To enhance an effective liaison and interaction with the NCOP.

Core function(s)

The core objective of the department is to pass laws for the North West Province and to oversee organs of state.

Main services to be delivered by the Legislature

The following are the main services, which are going to be delivered by the North West Provincial Legislature:

- To pass or amend a constitution for the North West Province;
- To pass Legislation for the North West Province;
- To recommend to the National Assembly legislation concerning any matter outside the authority of the North West Legislature, or where national law prevails over the provincial law;
- To oversee the activities of the Executive Council and other organs of state; and
- To ensure public participation in the legislative and oversight activities of the Legislature.

Demand for and the changes in the services of the Legislature

Currently the Legislature is made up of 33 Members of Provincial Legislature (MPL's). Of these Members, 11 are Members of the Executive Council. The remaining 22 MPL's, led by the Speaker, are the ones who must execute the mandate of the Legislature as outlined in the constitution. It also has an administrative staff of 80 people with the Secretary as the Accounting Officer.

We do not anticipate any major changes in the services of the Legislature. In addition to our normal/usual services, we are going to induct all MPL's after the elections.

Depending on the forthcoming 2004 election process, the eminent change in parliamentary seats will dictate otherwise.

2. REVIEW OF THE CURRENT BUDGET YEAR

The following were the achievements for the 2003/04 financial year:

- The implementation of the new organizational structure for the Legislature is nearly complete. The process included new appointments as well as the evaluation of the remaining posts.
- The Management Board has approved performance management, remuneration, promotion, procurement and pool vehicle policies.
- The Employment Equity Act has been submitted to the Department of Labour.
- A draft Fraud Prevention Plan has been drawn up and will be submitted to the Management Board for adoption.
- We successfully held the following parliaments: Workers, Youth, Women and Older Persons.
- Members of Parliament undertook official trips to: Malaysia, India, USA, Canada and Bangladesh.
- The extension to the building was started.

3. STRUCTURAL CHANGES

In the light of the objectives of the Legislature and of the achievements of the 2003/04 financial year, the Legislature aims to maintain and improve upon the following aspects of the programmes and to introduce the following new sub-programmes during the coming financial year:

Programme 1: Administration

Internal Audit

Objective: To perform an internal audit function in the North West Provincial Legislature.

Programme 3: Parliamentary Operations

Speaker's Office

Objective: To enable the Speaker to run his office affairs effectively and efficiently with his budget.

Committee's Activities

Objective: To enable the committees to effectively and efficiently perform their duties.

4. OUTLOOK FOR THE COMING BUDGET YEAR

For the coming budget year, we are going to have a programme for inducting new MPL's as well as addressing the issues that make us not to achieve our objectives. The following achievements are anticipated for the forthcoming year:

- Induction of MPL's after the elections;
- To address the poor public understanding and awareness of the existence of the Legislature;
- To address the lack of control over budgetary allocations to the Legislature;
- To ensure better coordination between the programs of the Legislature, Departments and NCOP;
- To address the lack of capacity in the Office of the Speaker to ensure that full responsibility for the Legislature treasury function can be undertaken;
- To address the lack of capacity and accountability to execute the constitutional mandate of the Legislature in terms of Schedule 4 and 5;
- To develop a strategy to address the high staff turnover.

The following uncertainties could have an impact in meeting our goals and objectives:

- Uncertainty over the future existence of Legislature as a sphere of Government;
- Uncertainty over the budget for committee activities due to changing schedules and unpredictable attendance.
