(As introduced)



(BY THE MEMBER OF THE EXECUTIVE COUNCIL RESPONSIBLE FOR FINANCE)

BILL

To provide for the appropriation of money from the Provincial Revenue Fund for the requirements of the Province of the Eastern Cape in the 2006/07 financial year and to provide for matters incidental thereto.

PREAMBLE

WHEREAS section 226(2) of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, 1996 provides that money may be withdrawn from the Provincial Revenue Fund only in terms of an appropriation by a provincial Act;

AND WHEREAS section 26 of the Public Finance Management Act, 1999 (Act No. 1 of 1999) provides that the Provincial Legislature must appropriate money for each financial year for the requirements of the Province;

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the Legislature of the Province of the Eastern Cape, as follows:—

Definitions

1. In this Act, unless the context indicates otherwise, any word or expression to which a meaning has been assigned in the Public Finance Management Act has the meaning assigned to it in that Act and —

"Act" includes the Schedule;

"conditional grants" means allocations to the province, from the national government's share of revenue raised nationally, provided for in section 214(1)(c) of the Constitution of the Republic of South Africa, 1996;

"current payments" means any payments made by a provincial department in respect of the operational requirements of that department, and includes, amongst others, payments for the compensation of employees, goods and services, interest, rental of immovable property and financial transactions relating to assets and liabilities, but exclude transfers and subsidies and payments for capital assets:

"payments for capital assets" means any payments made by a provincial department –

- (a) for assets that can be used continuously or repeatedly in production for more than one year, and from which future economic benefits or service potential is expected to flow directly to the provincial department making the payment; and
- (b) that must be classified as or deemed to be payments for capital assets in accordance with the "Reference Guide to the new Economic Format" (November 2003, Version 2) and the "Asset Management Framework" (April 2004, Version 3.3), issued by the National Treasury under section 76 of the Public Finance Management Act;

"Public Finance Management Act" means the Public Finance Management Act, 1999 (Act No. 1 of 1999); and

"transfers and subsidies" means any payments made by a provincial department to another organ of state or any other person in respect of which the provincial department does not receive anything of similar value directly in return.

Appropriation of money for the requirements of the Province

- 2. (1) Appropriations by the Legislature of the Province of the Eastern Cape of money from the Provincial Revenue Fund for the requirements of the Province in the 2006/07 financial year, to votes and main divisions within a vote, and for the specific listed purposes, are set out in the Schedule.
- (2) Subject to section 3, spending of appropriations is subject to the Public Finance Management Act.

Appropriation listed as specifically and exclusively

3. Despite the provisions of any law, appropriations to a vote or main divisions within a vote that are listed as specifically and exclusively may only be utilised for the purpose indicated and may not be used for any other purpose, unless an Act of the Legislature of the Province of the Eastern Cape amends or changes the purpose for which it was allocated.

Short title and commencement

4. This Act is called the Eastern Cape Appropriation Act, 2006, and comes into operation on 1 April 2006.



To appropriate amounts of money for the requirements of the Province of the Eastern Cape for the financial year ending 31 March 2006 and to provide for matters incidental thereto.

BE IT ENACTED by the Legislature of the Province of the Eastern Cape, as follows:-

Appropriation of amounts of money for the requirements of the Province of the Eastern Cape

1. Subject to the provisions of the Public Finance Management Act, 1999 (Act No. 1 of 1999), there is hereby appropriated adjusted amounts of money from and to departments into and out of the Provincial Revenue Fund for the requirements of the Province of the Eastern Cape in respect of the financial year ending 31 March 2006, the adjusted amounts of R25 609 000 (Twenty five million six hundred and nine thousand rand) as shown in the Schedule hereto.

Short title

2. This Act is called the Adjustments Appropriation Act, 2006 (Eastern Cape).

EXPLANATORY MEMORANDUM ON ADJUSTMENTS APPROPRIATION **BILL, 2006 (EASTERN CAPE)**

PART A

(Principles)

- Section 27(2) of the Public Finance Management Act, 1999 (Act No.1 of 1. 1999) empowers the MEC for Finance in a Province to table the provincial annual budget for a financial year in the Provincial Legislature to appropriate moneys in the Revenue Funds as a charge against the Revenue Account for the requirements of the Province.
- Section 31(2) of the Act then provides for an adjustments budget of a 2.
 - the appropriation of funds that have become available to the province; (a) (b)
 - unforeseeable and unavoidable expenditure recommended by the provincial Executive Council of the province within a framework determined by the Minister;
 - any expenditure for emergency situation in terms of section 25; (c) (d)
 - money to be appropriated for expenditure already announced by the MEC for Finance during the tabling of the annual budget; (e)
 - the shifting of funds between and within votes or to follow the transfer of functions in terms of section 42;
 - the utilisation of savings under a main division within a vote for the **(f)** defrayment of excess expenditure under another main division within the same vote in terms of section 43; and (g)
 - the roll-over of unspent funds from the preceding financial year.
- The reasons for introducing the Bill are to provide for: 3.
 - the appropriation of funds that have become available to the province; (a) (b)
 - the shifting of funds between and within votes or to follow the transfer of functions in terms of section 42;
 - the utilisation of savings under a main division within a vote for the (c) defrayment of excess expenditure under another main division within the same vote in terms of section 43; and
