1. STRATEGIC OVERVIEW OF INFRASTRUCTURE PROGRAMME FOR 2006/07 MTEF

Strategic Departmental Objectives

2. REVIEW OF 2005/06 INFRASTRUCTURE PROGRAMME

The Department of Agriculture Conservation and Environment (DACE) has successfully completed a number of infrastructure projects for the year. Some of the completed projects include:

- Alice Glockner resource centre and guest house.
- Kiepersol camp on Suikerbosrand Nature reserve.
- Finishing of the student dormitories and refurbishment of the rondavels at Abe Bailey nature reserve.
- Completing finishes at Zeekoeigat hall at Roodeplaat nature reserve.

All the above projects were completed under the mandate and instructions of Public Works as they are the implementing agent. DACE is the co-ordinator of the projects and ensures that the buildings comply with its requested needs and that the contractors adhere to the nature reserves regulations, etc. The infrastructure unit has also kept close ties with Public Works to ensure that the projects progress in unison.

Approximately 250 labourers are employed each year to work on our infrastructure projects. Employment is done by contractors who are advised by Department of Public Works to employ local labour and that contributes to job creation.

3. OUTLOOK FOR THE 2006/07 MTEF INFRASTRUCTURE PROGRAMME

The two entrance gates at Suikerbosrand Nature Reserve have been planned and will be handed over to the contractor in the new calendar year. The upgrade of the water line at Suikerbosrand and maintenance work of facilities will also be undertaken during the year. The upgrade of the NG Kerk and Kumnandi guest houses will be planned during 2006/07 financial year and actual work will take place in 2007/08 financial year.
