## **2. REVIEW OF THE 2004/2005 FINANCIAL YEAR**

The Traffic Training college has been opened for Public training in 2004/05. One hundred students were admitted.

Upgrading of Praktiseer and Mankweng traffic stations has been completed and Bochum is 95% completed

The driver of the year competition has been successful

The department has rolled out the donkey cart project at Burgwal and Uitkyk

An agreement has been reached with the department of Education to start with the scholar transport. A pilot project has been implemented at Waterberg District

The Department has taken over the function of Airport Management from the Department of Finance and Economic Development.

The devolutions of functions to the municipalities has been done and we are remaining with five stations to be devolved.

The upgrading of Mansole Traffic Control Centre has been completed with the assistance of SANRA

The first phase of the restructuring of Great North Transport in terms of NLTTA has been completed. Phase two will be started in new registering authorities at Molemole, Aganang, Maruleng and Marble Hall and have been approved and registered

During the year the Premier announced the reconfiguration of the department in the Province resulting in transfer of roads infrastructure from Public Works to Transport. Therefore the budget for this programme is accounted for in Public Works up to March 2005.

The budget allocated to this programme as R 952,449,000 which include

R 650,250,000 for transfer payments to Provincial Roads Agency

All programmes that were set out at the beginning of the financial year have been initiated and they will be:-

Repair, reseal and fogspray

Construction-2 bridges

Flood Damage

Equitable share: allocation for tarring Km of various gravel roads

Rehabilitation-16Km

Bridge construction-4

Programme of 6 months of job rotation-to address multi skilling

In terms of mobile laboratory, material have been bought and personnel identified for training

Contractor development on roads maintenance to be covered through Expanded Public Work program and the target is to identify 10 emerging contractors

## **3. OUTLOOK FOR THE 2005/06**

Mhala and Nebo K53 Testing ground will be upgraded.

A satellite Traffic station will be established on the R97 road.

The mines in the Sekhukhune District area and Phalaborwa has agreed to enter into a joint venture with the department to implement and assist with funding the transport system for the areas.

The department will start with the treatment of the pedestrian hazardous location at Maphalle and Thohoyandou/Sibasa CBD  
A road safety audit will be conducted on the R37 road

20% of the interim contracts will be converted into negotiated and tender contracts

Completing phase two of the restructuring of Great North Transport in terms of the Cabinet approval

The airport in the province will be upgraded starting with Polokwane International Airport

The department will continue with the devolution of traffic function to the municipalities

Implement the fencing project and establish resting areas on the tarred roads

Provide 615Km of tarred roads through the Limpopo Road agency

To increase the efficiency and effectiveness of service delivery

To continue implement labour-intensive rural road programme

EPWP Programme- Contractor development- labour intensive road maintenance and erection of fences

More resting places on Provincial roads @ 50km

Continue erecting place name change signs

Road signs for provincial nature reserves

Road signs for speed prosecution on the N1 will be supplied to National Road Agency

Challenge to acquire a Mobile Training vehicle- through Corporate Services

Intensive technical training to enhance the quality of maintenance to improve efficiency and service delivery.

### **Programme 3. PUBLIC TRANSPORT**

**Purpose:** To plan, regulate and facilitate the provision of public transport services and infrastructure, through own provincial resources and through co-operation with national and local authorities, as well as the private sector in order to enhance the mobility of all communities particularly those currently without or with limited access. The expanded public works programme is one of the methods utilized to deliver these services

To manage the processes of regulating public transport operations, including the registration of operators and the processing of applications for operating licenses

To provide the support structure, material human resources to the operating licensing board, the provincial transport registrar of public of public transport operators and other statutory bodies established in terms of legislation, so as to provide the necessary control, regulation and quality of services provided by the private sector

##### **Sub-Programme 3.3 Empowerment and Institutional Management**

To ensure that persons in the industry who provide and manage public transport are empowered to perform their function and receive adequate training to enable them to provide the required level of service

##### **Sub-Programme 3.4 Operator Safety and Compliance**

To promote and improve safety on the public transport system and to co-ordinate compliance with public transport legislation and regulations as well as the liaison and co-ordination of national, provincial and local safety and compliance initiatives

##### **Sub-Programme 3.5 Planning**

To develop the statutory plans required in terms of the National Land Transport Transition Act, 200(NLTCA) (Act 22 of 2000) to give effect to the mission, vision and objectives of the Branch.
