## 1 Overview

### 1.1 Vision

Integrated Sustainable Human Settlements with improved quality household lives by 2030, for residents of Eastern Cape.

### 1.2 Mission

Provide quality, integrated and sustainable human settlement that offer our communities a better living environment.

### 1.3 Core functions and responsibilities

- Rural settlement development;
- Informal settlement development and upgrading;
- Provision of rental and social housing;
- Provision of title deeds to beneficiaries; and
- Installation of services that include other amenities.

### 1.4 Main Services

- Housing facilitation and emerging contractors' empowerment;
- Housing project management and quality assurance services;
- Housing policy, planning and research services;
- Consumer education, capacitation and accreditation of municipalities services; and
- Housing subsidy administration services.

### 1.5 Demands for and expected changes in the services

The influx of people in the urban areas increases the number of backlogs and informal settlements. This is creating pressure in the shrinking Human Settlement Development grant. This requires intense planning and reprioritisation by the department. New strategies are to be explored as to how to deal with this pressure. The department has taken a bold approach to prioritise beneficiaries who need services. The directive is to provide services to the poorest of the poor that is destitute beneficiaries, elderly, disabled, disaster affected beneficiaries, and child headed households and military veterans.

## **1.6 The Acts, rules and regulations**

Section 26 of the Constitution form the primary basis of the mandate of the department and the following Acts: 1994 White Paper on Housing; Housing Act 107 of 1997 and the 2004 Comprehensive Plan for the Development of Sustainable Human Settlements. There are a number of Acts that have been promulgated to further support the department's constitutional mandate and these include, among others, the Prevention of Illegal Eviction from Unlawful Occupation of Land Act 19 of 1998; the Housing Consumer Protection Measures Act 95 of 1998; the Rental Housing Act 50 of 1999, (as amended); Home Loans and Mortgage Disclosure Act 63 of 2000 and Social Housing Act 16 of 2008. Other legislative issues affecting the creation of integrated human settlement include the allocation of powers and responsibilities to national departments, provincial and local governments to promote an environment conducive for sustainable and quality human settlements.

The revisions to legislative and other mandates have been due to the following relevant court rulings:

- Government of the Republic of South Africa v Irene Grootboom & Others: CCT 11/00 (right of access to adequate housing);
- Thubelitsha Homes, Minister of Housing and Minister of Local Government & Housing, Western Cape Various Occupants, the City of Cape Town and FirstRand Bank Limited: CCT 22/08 (eviction of 20 000 residents of Joe Slovo informal settlement); and
- Bio-watch Trust Registrar Genetic Resources & others: CCT 80/08 Dingaan Hendrik Nyathi v MEC for the Department of Health, Gauteng, and Minister of Justice & Constitutional Development: CCT 19/07.

## **1.7 Budget decisions**

The current economic climate and the constraints placed on provincial financial resources has directed the department to prioritise its budget allocation within its programmes within the limited resources. The department will continue with its efforts of delivering good quality houses to qualifying beneficiaries. Budget decisions in the department are largely influenced by the increasing demand of houses and migration patterns to the urban areas. In addition, the department is expected to adapt to these changes and demands, whilst the conditional grant allocation continues to shrink.

The department continues to implement cost containment measures in all items taking into cognisance the decline in the Equitable Share allocations. Decisions taken on allocations are based on the departmental Annual Performance Plan and Operational Plan. The allocations are aimed at ensuring that the department continues to deliver good quality houses.

## **1.8 Aligning departmental budgets to achieve government's prescribed outcomes**

The department's budget is aligned to the Medium-Term Strategic Framework (MTSF) and Provincial Medium-Term Strategic Framework priority number 4, whose objective is "Spatial Integration, Human Settlements and Local Government". The ultimate impact is to achieve spatial transformation through improved integrated settlement development and linking job opportunities and housing opportunities.

The MTSF priority is linked to the Provincial Development Plan vision 2030, of which the Department of Human Settlements mainly contributes towards the realization of Goal 2: "An enabling infrastructure network". This goal seeks to ensure the development of sustainable and integrated settlements to ensure the eradication of informal settlements, build integrated urban settlements and fast track housing provision by providing diversity in housing products and finance option. Key actions include upgrading informal settlement, with focus on incremental settlement in towns, cities and metros; increasing allocation to non-conventional instruments and strengthening urban and rural settlement planning capacities.

## **2 Review of the current financial year (2019/20)**

### **2.1 Key achievements**

The department completed 6 503 of the planned 9 210 housing units and 697 of the planned 747 housing units were rectified in the third quarter. 5 444 households were connected to basic services. Within the Social Rental housing programme 333 of the planned 250 units were completed. The department has handed over 4 781 title deeds and transferred 1 511 post-1994 housing stock.

The department approved 95 of the planned 120 units for Finance Linked Individual Subsidy Programme (FLISP) and 210 Military Veterans were assessed and verified.

The Rental Housing Tribunal continues to regulate and enforce good relations between tenants and landlords and has resolved 205 disputes.

Through the implementation of the Expanded Public Works Programme (EPWP) 7 601 jobs were created against a target of 10 783 in the various categories of Women; Youth; Male and people with disabilities.

A total of 50 Youth Brigade were mobilized in Orange Grove Community Hall where National Youth Development Agencies (NYDA) facilitated life skills and job preparedness training program. Another 50 youth was mobilized in Matatiele where the National Home Builders Registration Council (NHBRC) facilitated on technical skills training, assisting quality assurance in home building industry. Learners were further trained to achieve competency in understanding NHBRC minimum technical requirements in all stages of construction.

### **2.2 Key challenges**

#### **Declining Fiscus**

The baseline reduction for both Equitable Share and Human Settlements Development Grant has negatively affected the departmental plans due to increased demand for houses. The shrinking fiscus will result in inadequate monitoring of construction of houses in the regions.

The human and financial resource constraints are continuing to be hindrance in the service delivery within the core programmes of the department. However, the department has adopted a principle of optimally utilizing available resources. The continuous decline in Equitable Share allocation as a result of the shrinking fiscus continue to compromise quality of service delivery as it supports conditional grant related activities. Departmental contractual obligations remain under funded due budget top slicing.

#### **Human Settlements Development Grant**

Service delivery in the Nelson Mandela Bay Municipality (NMBM) is not being implemented according to plan. The department allocated R525 million to Nelson Mandela Bay Municipality (NMBM) to deliver 2 857 units and 278 for rectification. To date 199 units have been completed, one (1) unit rectified at the cost of R51 million. Projects that were earmarked for implementation were not implemented due to planning and project enrolment delays, as a result of lack of co-operation from Nelson Mandela Municipality. This poor performance resulted to the Business Plan being revised and funds being redirected to other regions.

#### **Title Deeds Restoration Grant**

The department has underspent on the Title Deed Restoration Grant (TDRG) due to delays in pre-conveyancing activities. The department has procured additional resources for both pre-conveyancing and conveyancing activities in order to address the backlog in handing over historic and current Title Deeds.

### **3 Outlook for the coming financial year (2020/21)**

The department continues to deliver outputs that are aligned to Outcome 8 in pursuit of the National Development Plan's vision of sustainable decent living in human settlements and better quality of households.

The department plans to handover 7 758 newly built housing units to beneficiaries across the province, rectify 1 217 defective units, and service 5 381 sites. The department plans to hand over 300 houses to Military Veterans and 1 372 houses to Destitute and Vulnerable Groups. The department will provide housing opportunities through approval of housing subsidies through the Finance Linked Individual Subsidy Programme (FLISP)

In the 2020/21 financial year the department plans to transfer 500 pre 1994 title deeds and handover 3000 Title Deeds to beneficiaries through the Title Deeds Restoration program. There will be 15 300 job opportunities created through Extended Public Works Program.

The department will continue to rollout Youth Build programs in all the regions in an effort to upskill the youth. The programme aims at equipping unemployed youth with built-environment skills and training. The department is in partnership with the National Home Builders Registration Council, National Youth Development Agency and other relevant institutions such as Technical and Vocational Education and Training (TVET) colleges to train 200 youth.

### **4 Reprioritisation**

In light of the shrinking fiscus, the department has identified non-core items such as administration fees and ensured that the budget allocated to these items is minimal whilst on the other hand ensuring that core service delivery items and contractual obligations are budgeted for.

### **5 Procurement**

The department has appointed procurement committees to adjudicate and recommend bids (90/10 thresholds) and quotations (80/20 thresholds) to the Accounting Officer for approval. The department has standard leases in place for the rental of office equipment, cellular phone contracts and fleet services. The department will contact PT for all variation orders request.

Table 2 above reflects the summary of departmental receipts. The table consists of equitable share, conditional grant, and departmental receipts from 2016/17 to 2022/23 financial year. The actual receipts partially increased from R2.362 billion in 2016/17 to a revised estimate of R2.397 billion in 2019/20.

In 2020/21 the total receipts decreased by 3.4 per cent due to budget cuts in the conditional grant allocation in 2020/21. The departmental receipts decreased by 21.2 per cent from a revised estimate of R2.019 million to R1.591 million in 2020/21 due to once off expenditure recovery in respect of the staff debts.

The Conditional Grant allocations decreased by 7.6 per cent from the revised estimate of R2.023 billion in 2019/20 to R1.870 billion in the 2020/21 financial year

Table 3 above shows departmental receipts and collection. The departmental receipts have decreased from R2.401 million in 2016/17 to a revised estimate of R2.019 million in 2019/20. In 2020/21 departmental receipts decreased by 21.2 per cent which is ascribed to transactions in financial assets which is not planned for the year. The department generates its revenue from sales of goods and service and from interest earned on balances on trust accounts managed by municipalities. The departmental receipts decreased by 21.2 per cent from a revised estimate of R2.019 million to R1.591 million in 2020/21, due to once off expenditure recovery in respect of the staff debts.

## 7 Payment summary

### 7.1 Key assumptions

The following assumptions were taken into consideration when the budget was formulated.

- Provision for all critical vacant funded posts in the approved structure and warm bodies, ICS as per allocation letter;
- Inflation related items such as goods and services are based on CPI projections; and
- Cost containment measures, as issued by National Treasury Instruction Note 3 of 2017/18 and Provincial Treasury Instruction Note 4 of 2017/18 will be adhered to over the 2020 MTEF.

The expenditure will be based on the government financial prescripts and sector legislation.

Tables 4 and 5 above provide a summary of payments and estimates by programme and economic classification. The total payments increased from R2.362 billion in 2016/17 to a revised estimate of R2.397 billion in 2019/20. In 2020/21, the budget is projected to decrease by 3.4 per cent from R2.397 billion to R2.315 billion when compared to 2019/20 as a result of budget cuts on the Human Settlements Development Grant (HSDG). The budget comprises mainly of the HSDG, which accounts for about 80 per cent of the department's budget.

Compensation of Employees shows a growth of 9.5 per cent in 2020/21 from R364.691 million to R399.418 million when compared to 2019/20 revised estimate, which caters for improved conditions of service, vacant funded posts and pay progression. Goods and Services shows a negative growth of 7.7 per cent from a revised estimate of R43.040 million in 2019/20 to R39.712 million in 2020/21 due to baseline reduction. Transfers and Subsidies shows a decreased of 5.4 per cent from a revised estimate of R1.975 billion to R1.869 billion in 2020/21 financial year. This is the main cost driver of the department, which is mainly driven through housing delivery across the province, Rental and Social Housing and the

Upgrading of Informal Settlements (ISUP). Payments for Capital Assets shows a decrease of 51.1 per cent from a revised estimate of R13.616 million in 2019/20 to R6.656 million in 2020/21 due to baseline reduction.

Table 7 above shows the summary of departmental payments and estimates on infrastructure, expenditure from 2016/17 to 2019/20 and the planned budget for the 2020 MTEF. Infrastructure payments for the delivery of housing units are made through various housing instruments, which include Integrated Rural Development, Informal Settlements Upgrading (ISUP), Peoples Housing Process, Project Linked Subsidies and EPWP. Expenditure decreased from R1.998 billion in 2016/17 financial year to a revised estimate of R1.894 billion in the 2019/20 financial year. In 2020/21, there is a decline of 10 per cent due to budget cuts in the HSDG grant. ISUP and Title Deeds grants form part of the infrastructure budget.

The HSDG grant decreases by 1.2 per cent from R1.994 billion in 2016/17 to a revised estimate of R1.824 billion in 2019/20 due to a revision of the grant funding. Tables 10 and 11 above show the departmental payments and estimates by sub-programme and by economic classification. In 2016/17, the expenditure increased from R134.046 million to a revised estimate of R166.842 million in 2019/20. The budget is projected to decrease by 2.6 per cent from a revised estimate of R166.842 million to R162.574 million in 2020/21 due to national adjustments.

Compensation of Employees is the main cost driver of the programme's budget and it is projected to increase by 10.3 per cent from a revised estimate of R119.346 million in 2019/20 to R131.602 million in

2020/21. The decrease of 26.4 per cent is noted under Goods and Services and the decrease is due to the baseline reductions. Payments for Capital Assets decrease by 51.1 per cent respectively.

Tables 12 and 13 above shows departmental payments and estimates by sub-programme and economic classification. Expenditure increased from R15.704 million in 2016/17 to a revised estimate of R19.136 million in 2019/20. Compensation of Employees drives expenditure in this programme where it increases by 20.7 per cent from a revised estimate of R18.676 million in 2019/20 to R22.534 million in the 2020/21 financial year. Goods and Services decreased by 28.1 per cent from a revised estimate of R448 thousand in 2019/20 to R322 thousand in the 2020/21 financial year. The decrease is due to the baseline reductions with minimal adverse impact on service delivery.

Tables 15 and 16 above shows departmental payments and estimates by sub-programme and economic classification. The expenditure recorded in the 2016/17 financial year decreased from R2.201 billion to a revised estimate of R2.197 billion in 2019/20 financial year. The budget for the programme has decreased

by 6.7 per cent from a revised estimate of R2.197 billion in 2019/20 to R2.050 billion in 2020/21 financial year. The decrease is due to the budget cuts in the HSDG.

Compensation of Employees budget increased by 8.1 per cent from a revised estimate of R213.545 million in 2019/20 to R230.893 million in 2020/21. Goods and Services increased by 61.3 per cent from a revised estimate of R9.227 million in 2019/20 to R14.883 million in 2020/21. The increase is due to additional funding of R5 million received for the monitoring of housing projects and conducting awareness sessions on Finance Linked Subsidy Programs. Transfers and Subsidies are decreasing by 8.6 per cent in 2020/21.

Tables 18 and 19 above shows departmental payments and estimates by sub-programme and economic classification. The expenditure recorded in the 2016/17 financial year increased from R11.237 million to a revised estimate of R13.697 million in the 2019/20 financial year. The budget for the programme has increased by 477.6 per cent from a revised estimate of R13.697 million in 2019/20 to R79.117 million in 2020/21 due to the reallocation of the Title Deeds Restoration Grant previously under programme 3 and moved to programme 4.

The budget for Compensation of Employees increases by 9.6 per cent in 2020/21 to cater for pay progression and ICS adjustments. Goods and Services decreased by 35.8 per cent from a revised estimate of R573 thousand in 2019/20 to R368 thousand in 2020/21. The decrease is due to the baseline reductions and it has no material impact on service delivery.
