1. Overview

1.1 Vision

Integrated Sustainable Human Settlements with improved quality of household lives by 2030, for residents of Eastern Cape.

1.2 Mission

Provision of quality integrated and sustainable Human Settlements that offer our communities better living environment.

1.3 Core functions and responsibilities

- Upscaling the housing opportunities with special focus and prioritization of Destitute, Vulnerable Groups and Military Veterans.
- Systematic unblocking of historically blocked projects.
- Accelerated Registration and Issuance of Title Deeds to homeowners.
- Increase empowerment opportunities for SMMEs including women and youth.
- Upgrading of informal settlements and provision of social and economic amenities; and
- Continuous use and application of Innovative and Sustainable Building Technologies.

1.4 Main Services

- Housing facilitation and emerging contractor development;
- Housing project management and quality assurance services;
- Finance Linked Individual Subsidy Programme (FLISP);
- Informal settlements upgraded;
- Housing policy, planning and research services;
- Consumer education, capacitation, and accreditation of municipalities services;
- Housing subsidy administration services; and
- Title deeds registration and issuance.

1.5 Demands for and expected changes in the services

Even though the Eastern Cape Department Human Settlements had delivered more than 386 802 low-cost houses to qualifying beneficiaries, the supply of housing opportunities does not meet the ever-increasing demand of housing opportunities. Statistics SA, in 2016, reported that there are more than 600 000 households who need decent houses in the province. Over the years, the department had observed an influx of people in the urban areas leaving rural areas and this had a negative impact in the demands for social housing units in the urban areas. Moreover, these relocations increase the number of backlogs and informal settlements. Over the 2022 MTEF, the department's focus is still on changing lives of our people by providing quality homes to the needy, the destitute and most vulnerable beneficiaries as an intervention which rescues helpless people from trenches of poverty and homelessness.

1.6 The Acts, rules and regulations

The mandate of the department emanates from Section 26 of the RSA Constitution which provides that everyone has the right to have access to adequate housing. The state must take reasonable legislative and other measures, within its available resources, to achieve the progressive realisation of this right and no one may be evicted from their home, or have their home demolished, without an order of court.

The mandate of the National Department of Human Settlements is also embedded in Section 3 of the Housing Act of 1997 as amended which provides that the National government acting through Minister should determine national Policy. Such policy should, include norms and standards in respect of housing development. The national government should amongst other functions set broad national housing delivery goals and facilitate the setting of provincial and where appropriate, local government housing delivery goals.

There are several Acts that have been promulgated to further support the department's constitutional mandate and these include, among others:

- Prevention of Illegal Eviction from Unlawful Occupation of Land Act, 1998
- The Housing Consumer Protection Measures Act, 1998
- The Rental Housing Act, 1999 as Amended
- Social Housing Act, No.16 of (2008)
- Home Loan and Mortgage Disclosure Act, 2000
- Housing Development Agency Act [Act No. 23 of 2008]
- Community Scheme Ombud Service Act [Act No. 9 of 2011]
- Sectional Titles Management Act [Act No. 8 of 2011]
- Spatial Planning and Land Use Management Act (SPLUMA) [Act No. 16 of 2013]

1.7 Budget decisions

The department has adopted an approach of resource allocation, which considers the prescripts around cost containment measures and allocative efficiency while ensuring that key strategic priorities are met in line with the budget cuts over the 2022 MTEF. Decisions taken on allocations are based on the departmental Annual Performance Plan and Operational Plan. The allocations are aimed at ensuring that the department continues to deliver good quality houses.

Budget decisions in the department are largely influenced by the increasing demand of houses and migration patterns to the urban areas. In addition, the department is expected to adapt to these changes and demands, whilst its annual allocation of Equitable Share increases marginally.

The current COVID-19 alert level in our country will allow for improved service delivery in the environment that the department operates in as the bulk of the department's business deals with site visits and

interactions with communities. Further interactions also stem from tender briefings. The department will ensure that COVID-19 protocols remain a priority in the safekeeping of its officials and its external stakeholders whilst keeping service delivery at an optimum.

1.8 Aligning departmental budgets to achieve government's prescribed outcomes

The department's budget is aligned to the national priority number 8, whose objective is "Sustainable Human Settlements and Improved Quality of Household Life", with the aim to develop quality human settlements for dignified social and economic livelihoods and human development by focussing on the following:

- Develop human settlements within the identified regions in a sustainable manner and support urban spatial restructuring through well located human settlements;
- Develop and strengthen mechanisms and instruments for integrated physical planning through a long-term credible human settlement project pipeline;
- Improve access to social rental housing in cities and towns;
- Explore innovative applications of existing funding instruments and subsidy schemes;
- Ensuring tenure security and promoting ownership through speedy issuing of title deeds;
- Explore alternatives to contractor driven RDP housing development such as Housing Cooperatives Method, expanding the People's Housing Process and voucher schemes; and
- Rural housing.

The National Department of Human Settlements is embarking on a process of refining the Draft White Paper on Human Settlements, 2016. The White Paper will carve a development path and assist in the amendment of the Housing Act of 1997, as amended. This process will result in a review of the 2009 National Housing Code. The MEC has prioritised Military Veterans; Destitute and Vulnerable group in the 6th Administration therefore the policy serves as a yard stick to ensure proper implementation of the policy.

Further, the following policy mandates and priorities are primarily for steering the work of Department of Human Settlements:

- The National Development Plan 2030 (NDP) recognises that apart from the right of access to adequate housing being entrenched in the Constitution, it forms a key component to the country's economic development;
- National Department of Human Settlements has set out four strategic pillars for implementation in the 2019-2025 MTSF priorities. These priorities are aligned to the Departmental priorities which gave birth to the development of outcomes in the departmental Strategic plan 2020 – 2025;
- The Provincial Development Plan vision 2030 provide a clear long-term vision and agenda for growth and development of the Eastern Cape Province in a manner that uplifts the human condition by building on the strengths and opportunities of the province;
- The District Development Model (DDM) aims to improve the coherence and impact of Government service delivery with focus on 44 Districts and 8 Metros around the country as development spaces that can be utilised as centres of service delivery and economic development including the creation of jobs; and
- Priority 5: Spatial Integration, Human Settlements and Local Government of the Seven Priorities derived from the Electoral Mandate.

2. Review of the current financial year (2021/22)

2.1 Key achievements

The department continued with the implementation of its mandate, as at the end of the third quarter, the department completed 4 828 of the annual planned 7 442 housing units. Sites serviced were 4 319 of the annual planned 7 505 sites and 862 housing units were rectified.

The department approved 145 of the planned 190 units for the Finance Linked Individual Subsidy Programme (FLISP) and 322 Military Veterans were assessed and verified. 686 destitute and other vulnerable groups were assessed and verified for housing opportunities.

The Rental Housing Tribunal continues to regulate and enforce good relations between tenants and landlords and has resolved 205 disputes.

Through the implementation of the Expanded Public Works Programme (EPWP) 5 341 jobs were created against a target of 7 500 in 2021/22 in the various categories of Women, Youth, Male and people with disabilities. The Job Strategy further expanded the Emerging Contractor Support Programme whereby SMMEs are supported through formal training programmes and the provision of sub-contracting opportunities. 73 of 116 SMME contractor empowerment opportunities were created.

The department has an active Youth Brigade established in line with the National Youth Development Strategy to empower young people. In this current financial year, a total of 200 was targeted and managed to enrol 150 youth in the following categories: 58 male youth and 92 female youth in Amathole, Sarah Baartman and Buffalo City Metro Municipality.

Small, Medium and Micro Enterprises (SMMEs) support is one of the National and Provincial priority in the MTSF. The support provided entails the provision of work opportunities, facilitation of training and development of SMMEs in partnership with NHBRC, Training institutions (SEDA AND CETA). In increasing the participation of SMMEs in human settlements development, the department has now included the 30 percent clause in its Terms of Reference for all projects exceeding R30 million. In this period, the department has facilitated training for 73 SMMEs towards sustainable business enterprise.

2.2 Key challenges

The department is maintaining an organisational structure that was created to execute a housing mandate, which is not in line with the expectations of leading an agenda for creation of integrated and sustainable Human Settlements. The continuous decline in the equitable share allocation will affect negatively on service delivery.

It is important to indicate that the department has not been able to increase its human resource capacity for the past five years while service delivery demands and related challenges have been increasing continuously. Some of the most affected areas include, Project Management, Social Facilitation, Beneficiary Management, Title Deeds function and in critical support services such as Supply Chain Management, Contracts Management, Budget Office, Legal Services, and Information Communication Technology (ICT). All those that have capacity limitations are central to the service delivery value chain.

With the description of Housing from the Department of Local Government and Traditional Affairs in 2008 and the introduction of a revised mandate of the Department of Human Settlements, several significant challenges had to be addressed on the inherited projects from the previous developers. This led to the department revoking the developer status from the non-performing municipalities.

Since then, there has been a continuous effort by the department to identify and de-commit funding from projects that were blocked due to the above-mentioned challenges. This was done with the aim of optimising departmental and state resources that could then be redirected to performing projects and to rural areas of the province. All projects that have not moved for more than three years will be closed.

3. Outlook for the coming financial year (2022/23)

The department continues to be committed to the National Development Plan's vision of sustainable decent living in human settlements and better quality of household life the service delivery strategy of the department remains focused on delivering outputs that are aligned to Outcome 8.

As the bulk of the budget is Human Settlements Development Grant (HSDG) the department plans to build 7 666 new housing units across the province and 6 205 sites planned to be serviced. The target for the new housing units has increased from 7 442 in 2021/22 to 7 666 in 2022/23 financial year.

The department plans to deliver 300 units for Finance Linked Individual Subsidy Programme (FLISP), the target for FLISP has increased from 190 in 2021/22 to 300 in 2022/23. Target of 100 will be verified for Military Veterans. The department will rectify 1 120 defective houses for both Pre-1994 and Post-1994. 8 000 households will benefit from informal upgrading compared to 5 300 target for previous year. The department aims at continuing supporting 80 Small Micro and Medium Enterprises towards sustainable businesses.

The department is committed in cleaning all the old commitments on the Housing Subsidy System (HSS). Youth and Women initiatives are paramount therefore the department will create 200 empowerment opportunities through youth brigade programme and create 6 400 job opportunities through EPWP compliant projects.

4. Reprioritisation

The department has been systematic and focused on its change effort for improved service delivery even though the equitable share allocation has not matched the changes as the fiscus continues to shrink over the MTEF. The department is maintaining an organizational structure that was created to execute a housing mandate, which is not in line with the expectations of leading an agenda for creation of integrated and sustainable Human Settlements. The department reprioritised within its baseline to match the additional amount of R42.071 million received for operations.

5. Procurement

Over the 2022 MTEF, the department will maintain existing valid contracts and agreements for services relating to communication contracts, software licensing and the leasing of government vehicles.

The department's procurement will be aligned to the departmental procurement plan and the recently revised departmental SCM policy. The revision of the SCM policy has sought to streamline procurement processes through the utilization of panels of contractors, professional service providers and conveyancers through framework agreements. The department commenced with the implementation of the following three-socio economic amenities in 2021/22, which will be completed in 2022/23:

- Lwandlol'ubomvu Multi-Purpose Community Center (MPCC) in Ntabankulu Local Municipality the contractor has already started on site; and
- Tsomo MPCC in Intsika Yethu Local Municipality and Mnandi MPCC in Blue Crane Local Municipality are at procurement stage.

Furthermore, the department will:

- Continue to liaise with Provincial Treasury for all matters relating to SCM guidance;
- Capacitate the SCM staff on new policies, guidelines, and new frameworks;
- Continue to improve the LED strategy focusing on local procurement; and
- Strengthen the wider participation by all target groups in various categories of procurement.

Table 2 above shows the summary of departmental receipts. The main sources of receipts are the equitable share allocation and conditional grants. The departmental receipts increase from R2.350 billion in 2018/19 to a revised estimate of R2.613 billion in 2021/22. In 2022/23, the budget decreases by 6.3 per cent from a revised estimate of R2.613 billion to R2.448 billion due to additional funding received during 2021/22 adjustments for goods and services and rollover amounts for conditional grants, Human Settlements Development Grant (HSDG) and Title Deeds Restoration Grant.

The equitable share allocation increased from R374.045 million in 2018/19 to a revised estimate of R687.223 million in 2021/22 due to additional funding. In 2022/23 budget decreases by 35.3 per cent from a revised estimate of R687.223 million to R444.871 million due to additional funding of operational costs.

With conditional grants, the allocation increased by 4.0 per cent from the revised estimate of R1.926 billion in 2021/22 to R2.003 billion in the 2022/23 financial year due to EPWP grant.

Table 3 above shows the summary of departmental own receipts and collection per item. Departmental receipts decreased from R2.319 million in 2018/19 to a revised estimate of R1.814 million in 2021/22. The department generates its revenue from sales of goods and service, which includes rental of capital assets, commissions and from interest, earned trust accounts managed by municipalities. Receipt collection on rental of capital assets decrease due to the COVID-19 pandemic as most tenants occupying the flats are employed at the low-income earning sectors, which were negatively affected by the lockdown restrictions.

7. Payment summary

7.1 Key assumptions

The following assumptions were taken into consideration when the budget was formulated.

- Provision for all critical vacant funded posts in the approved structure and warm bodies.
- Inflation related items such as goods and services are based on CPI projections.
- The departmental cost-cutting measures, in conjunction with National Treasury Instruction notes, will continue to be adhered to over the 2022 MTEF.
- The expenditure will be based on the government financial prescripts and sector legislation.

Tables 4 and 5 above provide a summary of payments and estimates by programme and economic classification over the 2022 MTEF. Expenditure increased from R2.350 billion in 2018/19 to a revised estimate of R2.613 billion in 2021/22. Expenditure comprises mainly of the HSDG, which accounts for about 82 per cent of the department's budget. Overall, the budget decreased by 6.3 per cent from a revised estimate of R2.613 billion in 2021/22 to R2.448 billion allocated budget in 2022/23.

Compensation of Employees increased by 7.5 per cent in 2022/23, which caters for improved conditions of service.

Goods and Services increased by 20.2 per cent from a revised estimate of R43.973 million in 2021/22 to R52.840 million in 2022/23 due to additional funding received.

The main cost driver of the department's budget is the transfers and subsidies that decreased by 9.1 per cent from a revised estimate of R2.202 billion to R2.002 billion in 2022/23 due mainly to the rollovers for the HSDG grant in 2021/22. This cost driver is mainly driven through the delivery of houses, Rental and Social Housing and the Upgrading of Informal Settlements.

Payments for Capital Assets decrease by 8.8 per cent from a revised estimate of R14.809 million in 2021/22 to R13.500 million in 2022/23.

Table 7 above shows the departmental expenditure on infrastructure for the 2018/19 to 2021/22 and the 2022 MTEF. Infrastructure payments for the delivery of housing units through various housing instruments which include Integrated Rural Development, Informal Settlements Upgrading, Peoples Housing Process, Project Linked Subsidies and EPWP. Expenditure increased from R1.947 billion in 2018/19 financial year to a revised estimate of R2.200 billion in the 2021/22 financial year. The infrastructure budget shows a decrease of 9 per cent in the 2022/23 financial year when compared to the previous financial year. This is due to a substantial rollover received during the adjustment budget process of the 2021/22 financial year.

Tables 10 and 11 above show the departmental payments and estimates of expenditure per sub-programme and by economic classification. Total expenditure increased from R153.982 million in 2018/19 to a revised estimate of R166.341 million in 2021/22. The budget increased by 11.6 per cent from revised estimate to R166.341 million in 2021/22 to R185.707 million in 2022/23.

Compensation of Employees is the main cost driver of the programme's budget and is projected to increase by 11 per cent from a revised estimate of R115.755 million in 2021/22 to R128.448 million in 2022/23.

Expenditure on Goods and Services decreased from R38.489 million 2018/19 to a revised estimate of R33.678 million in 2021/22. The estimated budget increases by 29.6 per cent from a revised estimate of R33.678 million to R43.659 million in 2022/23. The increase is due to the additional funding received.

Payments for Capital Assets increased from R4.496 million in 2018/19 to a revised estimate of R14.809 million in 2021/22 due to additional funding and rollover funds received. There is a decrease of 8.8 per cent in 2022/23 from a revised estimate of R14.809 million to R13.500 million.

Tables 12 and 13 above show the departmental payments and estimates of expenditure per sub-programme and by economic classification. Total expenditure increased from R19.889 million in 2018/19 to a revised estimate of R19.951 million in 2021/22. The budget increased by 12.6 per cent from revised estimate to R19.951 million in 2021/22 to R22.456 million in 2022/23.

Compensation of Employees is the main cost driver of the programme's budget and it is projected to increase by 11.8 per cent from a revised estimate of R19.542 million in 2021/22 to R21.856 million in 2022/23.

Expenditure on Goods and Services increase from R320 thousand 2021/22 revised estimate to R500 thousand allocation in 2022/23. The budget increases by 56.3 per cent between 2021/22 and 2022/23 financial years. The increase is due to the impact of additional funding received.

Tables 15 and 16 above shows departmental payments and estimates by sub-programme and economic classification. The expenditure recorded in the 2018/19 financial year increased from R2.145 billion to a revised estimate of R2.395 billion in 2021/22 financial year. The budget for the programme has decreased

by 7.9 per cent from a revised estimate of R2.395 billion in 2021/22 to R2.207 billion in 2022/23 financial year, mainly due to a decrease in Incremental Interventions sub-programme.

Expenditure on compensation of employees decreased from R201.880 million in 2018/19 to a revised amount of R196.076 million in 2021/22. The budget increases by 4.4 percent from a revised amount of R196.076 million to R204.754 million in 2022/23 due to additional funding of cash gratuity in relation to wage agreement.

Expenditure on Goods and Services increased from R6.388 million in 2018/19 to a revised estimate of R9.437 million 2021/22. The budget allocation for 2022/23 is R8.581 million. There is a decrease of 9.1 per cent between 2021/22 and 2022/23.

Transfers and subsidies decreased by 8.9 per cent in 2022/23 from a revised amount of R2.189 billion in 2021/22 to R1.993 billion in 2022/23 financial due to rollover amount during the 2021/22 adjustment estimate for HSDG grant allocation.

Table 22 above is the information on training by programme and category. Over the 2022 MTEF period, training figures are mainly guided by needs analysis, which is a process that is linked to Employment Performance Management Development Systems (EPMDS). The EPMDS has identified training needs in project management for line function staff as well as finance and Supply Chain management (SCM) skills for corporate services staff. Training for the department is centralised in Programme 1. The training budget decreased from R1.500 million in 2018/19 to a revised estimate of R1.480 million in 2021/22. In 2022/23, training budget increased by 90.7 per cent from R1.480 million to R2.823 million due to budget adjustments.
