1.7. Aligning departmental budgets to achieve government's prescribed outcomes

In the 2023/24 financial year, the department will receive three conditional grants related to the delivery of services related to its mandate, namely, the Human Settlements Development grant (HSDG), the Informal Settlements Upgrading Partnership Grant (ISUPG) and the Expanded Public Works Programme Intergraded Grant (EPWPG). The Title Deeds Restoration Grant (TDRG) has been phased out and all expenditure relating to title deeds will be funded through the HSDG.

The department reprioritised its activities to contribute to the outcomes identified by the President to realize the following:

- Promote integrated sustainable urban settlements and improved quality of living as per the National Housing Code of 2009, which include tenure security, health and security as well as empowerment.
- The total allocation for the 2023/24 financial year amounts to R 1.103 billion and comprises of the following:
 - HSDG R 848.1 million
 - o ISUPG R 252.2 million
 - o EPWP R 2.591 million

It is expected that the HSDG allocation of R 848.1 million will deliver 2 093 serviced sites, 2 788 completed houses, 1 813 new title deeds and 4 805 for title deeds restoration. For ISUPG, the allocation of R 252.2 million will deliver 2 152 serviced sites for 2023/24 financial year.

In 2023/24 financial year, R 164.3 million of the Human Settlement Development Grant has been allocated to Mangaung and is expected to deliver 777 completed houses, 980 title deeds restoration and 225 new title deeds.

Lejweleputswa has been allocated an amount of R 216.4 million 130 and is expected to deliver 847 serviced sites, 496 completed houses, 140 title deeds restorations and 95 new title deeds.

Fezile Dabi has been allocated an amount of R 82. 6 million and is expected to deliver 323 completed houses, 1 818 title deeds restorations and 460 new title deeds.

Thabo Mofutsanyane has been allocated an amount of R 140.3 million and is expected to deliver 617 serviced sites, 315 completed houses, 1 288 title deeds restorations and 311 new title deeds.

Xhariep has been allocated an amount of R 117.5 million and is expected to deliver 629 service sites, 412 completed houses, 579 title deeds restorations and 247 new title deeds.

In projects that are spread across the province, an amount of R 126.6 million has been allocated and 465 units are to be delivered including provision of 445 new title deeds.

The allocation for the Informal Settlements Upgrading Partnership Grant for 2023/24 financial year is R 252.209 million and is allocated between the districts as follows:

- Fezile Dabi R 48.619 million
- Lejweleputswa R 107.967 million
- Thabo Mofutsanyane R 67.839 million
- Xhariep R 28.283 million

Explanation of planned performance over the medium-term period

Programme 1: Administration

The Department seeks to comply with critical provisions of the PFMA, Treasury Regulations and Risk management. This will be achieved through:

- Paying suppliers within 30 days
- Strengthening internal control by conducting and completing various internal audits.
- Improving skills of SMS members on risk management-related issues

Programme 2: Housing Needs, Research and Planning

The implementation of this programme seeks to address the integrated Human Settlements sector plans, review departmental policies in line with sector priorities, research potential projects in the province, and, above all, Invest the total of Human Settlements allocations in PDA's.

Programme 3: Housing Development

Department aims to provide adequate and improved quality living environments for the citizens of the Free State province. Through:

- Registration of title deeds to the rightful beneficiaries and eradication of backlog of the previous years.
- Servicing of sites and households,
- Construction of houses for qualifying beneficiaries
- Approvals on FLISP subsidies to qualifying beneficiaries.
- Stakeholder mobilization through consumer education on services offered by the Department to Free State citizens
- Implement socio-economic empowerment programmes and projects benefiting women, youth and persons with disabilities
- Enrolments through NHBRC and quality inspections at various stages of construction.
- Upgrading of informal settlements (UISP) to phase 3.
- Implementing catalytic projects that demonstrate spatial transformation targeting socio-economic integration
- Unblock blocked projects.
- Ensuring that planned ervens are surveyed.
- Create work opportunities through Human Settlements projects intervention.

Programme 4: Housing Asset Management

The Department currently has 5 properties waiting to be transferred to the rightful owners. The reason why the process of transferring these properties is proving to be challenging is that the properties were in different hands without the knowledge of the Department. The Department is in the process of finding a legal resolution to address this issue. In the meantime, the Department has enlisted the assistance of a body corporate to manage the maintenance and levies of these properties.

Challenges affecting departmental performance:

Programme 1: Administration

- Delays in approving the Organizational structure of the Department.
- Consequence management on targets that are not achieved in the Annual Performance Plan.
- Delays in procurement as a result of vacancies which in turn affect deliverables in the line function
- Management of tacit and explicit knowledge and career succession planning
- Improvement in audit outcomes.
- Risk assessment on the strategic thrust of the department.

Programme 2: Housing, Needs, Research and Planning

The in-year intervention of financial and non-financial targets that are set to perform in the last quarter of the financial year.

Programme 3: Housing Development

- Addressing and resolving disputes on the registration of title deeds
- Disputes in issuing low-costing housing.
- Slow progress on projects which in turn is causing underperformance on set targets
- Power cuts (Loadshedding) hampering progress on site.

Blocked Projects:

Projects that could not be completed due to either vandalism or being neglected.

3. Outlook for the current financial year (2023/24)

 The Department targets the Priority Human Settlement and Housing Development area for high density, mixed use, tenure and income development. To date a number of hectares of land was acquired for human settlement inside and outside the PHSHDA.

- The Department strives to deliver its mandate and implement all priorities advocated in the Human Settlement sector. This includes delivering all housing and land tenure typologies approach and ensuring that there is hygiene intervention by providing household and sites with water and sanitation. The department is implementing two deliverables to improve a number of serviced sites and household funded under the HSDG and UISP grants.
- Women, youth and people living with disabilities will be included in the mainstream of
 economic activities and opportunities. In an observed trend, our department still has
 to work hard in dismantling a patriarchal system that would address this. In record,
 there is an improved number of women and youth and People with disabilities who has
 been allocated projects from the Human Settlements Grant.

The following factors inform the departmental planning and service delivery:

Household Infrastructure

Drawing on the household infrastructure data of a region is of essential value in economic planning and social development. Assessing household infrastructure involves the measurement of the following indicators:

- · Access to dwelling units
- Access to proper sanitation
- Access to running water

A household is defined as a group of persons who live together and provide themselves jointly with food and/or other essentials for living, or a single person who lives alone.

Household by dwelling unit type- Free State and National

The Department is guided by The Housing Act 107 of 1997 and other prescripts in determining plans for household by dwelling unit type.

Future management of pandemic outbreak

The national department of Human Settlements has put together a strategy to deal with the spread of pandemic by putting focus on area of overcrowding and this includes households and individuals living in informal settlements, backyard shacks and hostels, with a particular emphasis on ensuring that there is access to water, pre and post virus access healthcare facilities, the provision of subsidized access for households to perform relevant hygiene practices and steps to allow for the densification, to take all required actions to ensure that urgent provision is made for de-densification. The assessment of informal settlements identified 22 settlements which were classified as both High Risk and Medium Risk. High Risk informal settlements were those without any access to water and medium risks are those where there was some form of access to water through the communal taps.

The department closely monitors a set of intervention indicators of the MTSF plan. Currently 52 percent of women are in the workforce of the department, however less representation in decision-making.

Youth

Youth numbers have dropped in the past 3 years, from 32 percent to 28 percent in terms on the workforce. The department is struggling to reach 50 percent of Women youth at SMS level. To date more youth were approved on the Financial Linked Subsidy Program as first time owners in the housing market.

Persons with disabilities

The department still have a challenge on allocating this directive to relevant programme owners. There is no representation of disability at SMS, MMS level. With regard to the work force the department is standing at 0,5 percent of persons with disabilities employed. The department aims at including persons with disability in the socio-economic mainstream. At least 7 percent of persons with disability are to benefit on allocated projects from Human Settlements Development Grant (HSDG).

Institutional Arrangement

The Constitution assigns housing as a concurrent function of national and provincial government. The Housing Act (1997) outlines the responsibilities of national, provincial and local government for housing delivery. The national Department of Human Settlements develops policy and strategy, determines delivery goals, monitors and evaluates sector performance, establishes a national funding framework for housing development, and allocates the housing subsidy budget to provincial departments and public entities.

Unemployment

According to Quarterly Labour Force Survey, employment increased by 204 000 in the third quarter of 2022 following an increase of 648 000 in the second quarter of 2022. Employment has mostly increased in the third quarters of each year since 2016, except for the decrease observed in 2021. The results further confirm that this was the fourth consecutive increase in employment since Q4: 2021. The formal sector employment increased in six of the eight industries in Q3: 2022. The main contributors to the increase in the formal sector employment were Manufacturing (104 000), Trade (90 000), Construction (42 000) and Transport (15 000) industries. However, the decline in the formal sector employment was recorded in Finance (26 000) and Community and social services (4 000) in Q3: 2022 compared to Q2: 2022. Compared to a year ago, a net gain of 1,2 million jobs in the formal sector employment was mainly driven by the Community and social services (551 000), Trade (369 000) and Manufacturing (213 000) industries in Q3: 2022. Finance (23 000) and Transport (8 000) industries recorded employment losses during the same period.

Income

The South African gross domestic product (GDP) has increased by 1.6 percent in the third quarter of 2022. There is a slight increase as compared to the 1.2 percent in the third quarter of 2021. source: Statistics South Africa.

4. Reprioritisation

In the 2023/24 financial year the indicative baseline for Programme 1: Administration has a total decrease of R 1.200 million which these funds have been reprioritized towards Programme 3: Housing Development which increased by R 1.200 million. After this reprioritization took place, Programme 1: Administration's reprioritized baseline amounted to R 134.618 million from R 134.949 million and Programme 3: Housing Development, from R 1.208 billion indicative baseline to R 1.214 billion as a reprioritized baseline.

The reprioritization was made to increase the economic classification item, Goods and Services towards Equitable Share Funding as not enough funding was available for Contractual Obligation items which have been allocated within Programme 3: Housing Development.

For Conditional Grant in the Programme 3: Housing Development the sub-programmes Financial Interventions, Incremental Interventions and, Social and Rental Interventions were decreased in order to accommodate Rural Interventions which have been included in the 2023/24 financial year as stated on the respective Business Plan (Table B5) for the same year. Rural Interventions now has a reprioritized baseline amounting to R 32.2 million of which funds have been reprioritised from the above mentioned interventions.

5. Procurement

The establishment of policies in line with Section 217 of the Constitution which give guidance to procedures, sound systems of control and accountability for the Departmental reform. The primary objective of the Department is to provide adequate shelter to the beneficiaries and to build sustainable human settlements, and this can only be achieved through the utilization of procurement as a tool to promote economic spinoff of the country.

Furthermore, the tenders are advertised in line with the Preferential Procurement Regulations, 2022. In an effort to advance previously disadvantaged groups. The department ensures cost effectiveness and value for money through recommending

bidders who have quoted market related prices after the competitive bidding process or price quotations.

The Department continues to ensure that it complies with the relevant prescripts to ensure that, among other things, integrated human settlements, infrastructure delivery are prioritised.

Moving forward to 2023/24, the Department will spend substantial budget on procurement contractors to do the following projects:

- Creation of serviced sites
- Blocked Projects
- Mud Houses
- Revitalisation Programme
- Military Veterans
- Title Deeds Restoration
- Upgrading of Informal Settlements

The Department continues to build municipal capacity and skills to increase the number of officials at municipal level so that they can improve their performance and take on increased responsibilities such as beneficiary registration, consumer education, site identification etc.

7. Payment summary

7.1. Key assumptions

The following assumptions were taken into consideration during the preparation of the Departmental budget:

- Equitable share decreased by R3.7 million or 1.4 percent in 2023/24 and increased by R6.2 million or 2.3 percent in 2024/25 and increased by R8.7 million or 3.1 percent in the outer year.
- Conditional Grants increased by R 46.1 million or 4.4 percent in 2023/24 and increased by R46.8 million or 4.2 percent in 2024/25 and increased by R 51.5 million or 4.5 percent in the outer year.
- The allocation for the Earmarked funding: Demolition and Construction of two roomed houses for 2023/24 amounts to R 25 million, for 2024/25 amounts to R30 million and for 2025/26 amounts R 30 million.
- The Department allocated the amount of R208.6 million for Compensation of Employees in 2023/24 financial year, R 210.2 million in 2024/25 and in 2025/26 the amount of R 211.9 million was budgeted for Compensation of Employees.
- The budget for Goods and Service amount to R 46.7 million in 2023/24 and is allocated R 35 million towards Equitable Share Funding, and R 11.7 million for Conditional Grant. In 2024/25 financial year the total allocation for Goods and Services is R 57.6 million and is distributed into R34.6 million and R23 million respectively between Equitable Share Funding and Conditional Grant. The outer year 2025/26 has been allocated an amount of R69.8 million towards Goods and Services of which R41.3 million is Equitable Share Funding and R28.5 million Conditional Grant.
- In terms of Payments for Capital assets, the amount of R1.8 million was allocated in 2023/24, the allocation remained unchanged in the 2024/25 allocation as R 1.8 million and increased to R2.1 million in the outer year.

The 2023/24 total budget for the Department is R1.3 billion and increased by 3.9 percent to R1.4 billion in 2023/24 and further increased by 4.2 percent to R1.4 billion in the outer year.

7.5. Conditional Grants

The Conditional Grant allocation (Allocation from National Funds) has increased by 4.4 percent.

Human Settlements Development Grant (HSDG)

The allocation of the Human Settlement Development Grant was R813.041 million in 2022/23. The allocated 2023 MTEF budget is R848.099 million, R886.187 million in 2024/25 and R925.888 million in the outer year of 2025/26.

In terms of the Division of Revenue Bill of 2022, Human Settlements Development Grant seeks to establish habitable, stable and sustainable human settlements in which all citizens have access to social and economic amenities. Over the 2023/24 financial year, a total of R1.103 billion has been allocated to this grant.

As per the DORB, the HSDG framework contains a number of earmarks and set-asides, which restrict the provinces' discretion in allocating the funds:

- Up to 5 percent for operational capital budget programme to support project implementation
- Up to 5 percent for provision of bulk infrastructure projects for basic services in non-metro municipalities
- Up to 30 percent for bulk infrastructure, as per framework developed by DHS in consultation with National Treasury
- At least 2 percent for the implementation of innovative building technologies approved by South African Bureau of Standards

Although no funds have been ring-fenced for mining towns this current financial year, a smaller amount of R 146.041 million has been dedicated to Matjhabeng Local Municipality.

Informal Settlements Upgrading Partnership Grants (ISUPG)

The ISUPG is a relatively new grant, first introduced in 2021/22 to intensify efforts to upgrade informal settlements in partnership with communities. Prior to that, funds meant for informal settlement upgrading were earmarked in the HSDG, but in order to provide greater focus and to enable better monitoring, the earmarked funds from the HSDG were pulled out into separate Schedule 5A and 5B grants for informal settlements, to be transferred to provinces and the metros respectively.

More specifically the grant is intended to increase investment in in-situ upgrading including the identification of informal settlements for upgrades, providing households with security of tenure and providing municipal engineering services. In order to successfully carry out this work, the ISUPG places an emphasis on building partnerships with communities. As a requirement of the grant, Provinces must submit a business plan for informal settlements upgrading, which includes project descriptions, the project institutional arrangements, a sustainable livelihood implementation plan, outputs and targets for services to be delivered, a risk management plan, a procurement plan and cash flow projections.

During the 2021/22 financial year there was an implementation of the Informal Settlements Upgrading Partnership Grant. This grant is a schedule 5 grant and it is aimed at the creation of sustainable and integrated human settlements that enable improved quality of

household life. It is to provide funding to facilitate a programmatic and inclusive approach to upgrading informal settlements.

The outcomes of the Upgrading of Informal Settlements are as follows:

- Programmatic province-wide informal settlements upgrading strategy
- Number of approved individual informal settlements upgrading plans prepared in terms of the National Upgrading Support Programme (NUSP)
- Number of social compacts or agreements concluded with communities and/or community resource organisations outlining their role in the upgrading process
- Number of informal settlements designated for upgrading in terms of the municipal Spatial Development Framework (SDF) and Spatial Planning and Land Use Management Act (SPLUMA) and municipal by-laws enacted in this regard
- Number of households provided with secure tenure
- Number of households provided with individual municipal engineering services (water services, sanitation solutions and electricity – grid and non-grid)
- Number of informal settlements provided with interim and permanent municipal engineering services (public lighting, roads, storm water, refuse removal and bulk connections for water, sanitation and electricity)
- Number of households benefited from interim services
- Hectares of land acquired for relocation of category B2 and category C settlements (categories in terms of NUSP methodology)
- Hectares of land acquired for in situ upgrading for category B1 settlements
- Number of in situ individually serviced sites developed
- Value of funds leveraged

The Informal Settlements Upgrading Partnership Grant: Provinces is a long term grant as government must assist the poor with the provision of human settlements in terms of the Constitution.

The 2023 MTEF allocation the Informal Settlements Upgrading Partnership Grant: Province R 252.2 million for 2023/24, R 263.5 million for 2024/25, and the amount of R 275.3 million in 2025/26 respectively.

As a condition of the grant, at least 70 percent of the provinces allocated funds must be spent on infrastructure. Having assessed projects that are ready for implementation for the 2023-24 financial year, the allocation for Permanent Infrastructure is 64.2 percent, which will yield in total 1 349 serviced sites with both water and sanitation reticulation and additional 1 700 sites serviced with water only. A request to deviate from this requirement has already been submitted to National Department of Human Settlements and awaiting outcome.

Expanded Public Works Programme Integrated Grant for Provinces (EPWP)

The Expanded Public Works Programme (EPWP) integrated grant for provinces incentivises provincial departments to use labour-intensive methods in infrastructure, environmental and other projects. Grant allocations are determined upfront based on

the performance of provincial departments in meeting job targets in the preceding financial year. The grant is allocated R2.591 million in the 2023/24 financial year.

Programme 3: Housing Development

- Informal Settlements Upgrading Partnership Grant: the primary objective of this grant is to cater for the special development requirements of informal settlement.
- Expanded Public Works Programme (EPWP) Integrated Grant: This is one of government's key programmes aimed at providing poverty and income relief through temporary work for the unemployed. The programme provides an important avenue for labour absorption and income transfers to poor households, in the short to medium-term.

9.2. Programme analysis

Programme 1: Administration has been allocated a budget of R134.6 million for the 2023/24 financial year and the decrease from the previous year's budget amounts to R17.4 million which is 11.5 percent decrease. This is due to the 2023 MTEF allocation which decreased total Provincial Funds for the department by 0.9 percent and reprioritising more funds towards Earmarked Funding. The budget is set to increase across the outers years as 2024/25 allocations amounts to R 136.1 million an increase of 1.1 percent and 2025/26 an increase was made as the allocation is R142 million or 4.4 percent increase.

The programmes main spending items include Audit Fees, Fleet Services and Operating Payments related to the lease of government vehicles. These are the core items, which assist the programme to achieve its objectives, and they are in-line with the departmental policy.

Programme 2: Housing Needs, Research and Planning has been allocated a budget of R 23.3 million for the 2023/24 financial year and an increase from the previous year's budget amounts to R1 million which is 4.7 percent. This is due to the next financial years revised inflation projections which is 5.1 percent. The budget is set to increase slightly across the outers years as 2024/25 allocations amounts to R 23.3 million, an increase of 0.2 percent and in 2025/26 an increase of 0.6 percent which gives an allocation of R23.5 million.

The programmes main spending items include Travel and Subsistence, Training and Development. These are the core items, which assist the programme to achieve its objectives, and they are in-line with the departmental policy.

Programme 3: Housing Development has been allocated a budget of R1.2 billion for the 2023/24 financial year and an increase from the previous year's budget amounts to R51.5 million which is 4.4 percent specifically for Conditional Grant. The budget is set to increase across the outers years as 2024/25 allocations amounts to R1.2 billion an increase of 4.2 percent and 2025/26 allocations amounts to R1.3 billion an increase of 4.5 percent.

The programmes main spending items include Conditional Grants, Consultants and Professional services, Agency and Support, and Travel and Subsistence. These are the core items, which assist the programme to achieve its objectives, and they are in-line with the departmental policy.

Programme 4: Housing Assets Management has been allocated a budget of R2.2 million for the 2023/24 financial year and an increase of R0.8 million from the previous year's budget which is 59.7 percent. The budget is set to remain the same throughout the outers years. The programme provides for the effective management of housing.
