ACCOUNTING OFFICERS OF CONSTITUTIONAL INSTITUTIONS, AND NATIONAL AND PROVINCIAL DEPARTMENTS, HEADS OF PROVINCIAL TREASURIES AND ACCOUNTING AUTHORITIES OF PUBLIC ENTITIES

2019 REMUNERATION LEVELS: SERVICE BENEFIT PACKAGES FOR OFFICE-BEARERS OF CERTAIN STATUTORY AND OTHER INSTITUTIONS

- The Minister of Finance has <u>declined an amendment</u> to the service benefit packages for office-bearers of certain statutory and other institutions. The rates as indicated in Annexure A remain valid with effect from 1 April 2018.
- 2. The relevant category levels provide for all-inclusive flexible remuneration packages (inclusive of service benefits). Full-time members' remuneration packages must be structured in accordance with the principles of the Senior Management Service (SMS)^{1*}. In structuring the packages, office-bearers should make due provision for pension and medical aid and must also ensure that taxation rules governing the structuring of salary packages are complied with. The indicated rates are sitting fees and exclusive of payments in respect of preparation, research and travelling (to and from meeting venues) time. The rate per day is the maximum allowable remuneration in any 24-hour day irrespective of the number of boards/councils and/or committees non-official members serve on.
- 3. The relevant executive authorities need to ensure that the remuneration is affordable within the current MTEF budget framework. The extent to which the authorities wish to apply the remuneration should be based on the evaluation of work done by the office-bearers of the relevant institution. All expenditure must be defrayed from institutions'/ departments'/ public entities' existing budget allocations.
- Current VAT law requires non-executive directors (NEDs) of companies to register for and charge VAT in respect of any director's fees earned for services rendered as a nonexecutive director. Kindly note that the above rates are VAT inclusive.

The value of the fees must, however, exceed the compulsory VAT registration threshold of R1 million in any 12-month consecutive period but NEDs can voluntarily register for VAT as well. ²

5. Employees of National, Provincial and Local Government or Institutions, Agencies and Entities of Government serving as office-bearers on Public Entities/Institutions are not entitled to additional remuneration.
