- whether his department invoked any sections of the Public Finance Management Act, Act 1 of 1999, empowering him to use funds from national revenue to assist the Free State health department; if not, why not; if so, (a) how much revenue was used, (b) when was it transferred and (c) for what purpose was it intended;
- (3) whether the revenue amount transferred to the Free State health department was sufficient for them to lift the moratorium on all health services; if not, (a) what amount would have been sufficient and (b) why was the full amount not transferred?
