Mr M H Hoosen (ID) to ask the Minister of Finance:

(a) Which (i) serving and (ii) past members of Parliament are receiving a special pension and (b) what is the total amount per month that they are receiving?

Reply:

- (a) (i) Number of serving members of Parliament receiving special pension is 41
- (ii) Number of past members of Parliament receiving special pension is 58.

I am advised that the information sought concerns personal information and that I am not at liberty to disseminate it without the consent of the individuals concerned. The member is referred to the Members Interest Disclosure register should he wish to obtain the information.

- (b) The Code of Conduct for Assembly and permanent Council members, classifies the value of pension for Members of Parliament as confidential. Therefore, we cannot disclose the amount.
