DR DT GEORGE (DA) TO ASK THE MINISTER OF FINANCE:

- (1) Whether his Director-General signed a performance contract with him, if not, why not; if so, when?
- (2) Whether all senior managers in his department signed performance contracts with the Director-General; if not, (a) which senior managers did not sign, (b) for what reason and (c) when will it be done; (d) if so, on which date did each senior manager sign a performance contract?

REPLY:

- (1) The Director-General has signed his performance contract with the Minister within the requisite period determined by the DPSA, namely by the end of August 2009.
- Senior managers are not required to conclude performance contracts with the Director-General. They are however required to conclude contracts with their immediate superiors. It is only Divisional Heads who are required to have their respective contracts signed off by the Director-General. All the National Treasury Divisional Heads have concluded their performance contracts with the Director-General as required.
