(2) In terms of Treasury Regulation 15.8, at the end of each financial year, and after the books of account of a department have been closed, the accounting officer must surrender to the relevant treasury any unexpended voted money, for re-depositing into the Exchequer bank account of the relevant revenue fund. In line with this, unspent national vote funds were deposited into the National Revenue Fund for the 2012/13 and 2013/14 financial years. The funds for the 2014/15 financial year will be returned to the National Revenue Fund once the books have been closed and audited.
