How does the National Treasury enforce section 10 of the Money Bills Amendment Procedure and Related Matters Act, Act 9 of 2009, which allows for other committees to advise the Standing Committee on Appropriations regarding where a sub-division within a vote should be appropriated conditionally to ensure that the money requested for the main division will be spent effectively, efficiently and economically?

REPLY:

The compliance with section 10(5) of the Money Bills Amendment Procedure and Related Matters Act, 2009, is not the responsibility of the National Treasury. If another committee of Parliament advises the Standing Committee on Appropriations to appropriate funds conditionally, the Standing Committee on Appropriations must, when considering the Appropriation Bill concerned, deal with such advice.
