Whether there are any plans to close the SA Revenue Service (SARS) internal training centre; if not, what is the position in this regard; if so, what are the details of (a) the reasons for such a closure, (b) any SARS employees who will in any way be affected by such closure, including any employees who (i) will be retrenched and (ii) may have to be redeployed, (c) where the affected employees will be redeployed to, (d) the alternative training facilities that will be used, (e) the additional costs of alternative training facilities, including costs of travel to and from such alternative facilities and (f) what will be done with the (i) premises and (ii) equipment currently used for training?
