**★60. Mr W A S Aucamp (Northern Cape: DA) to ask the Minister of Finance:**

Whether, considering that we have a Budget deficit (details furnished) and there is no room for any mistakes, there are any possible further allocations that will be given to state-owned enterprises in this financial year; if not, what is the position in this regard; if so, what are the relevant details?

**REPLY:**

While the 2021 Budget includes funding for the Land Bank, this is envisaged to come from reprioritization, to ensure that the overall spending envelope is maintained. Any other funding aside from this is for government entities such as SARS (South African Revenue Service), government's commitment to the Infrastructure Fund (transfer to the Development Bank of Southern Africa) and South Africa's commitment to the New Development Bank (otherwise known as the BRICS Bank). There is no additional or new funding for any other state-owned enterprises in the budget. All other allocations that are in the baseline emanate from previous budgets.
