REQUEST FOR DEVIATION: APPOINTMENT OF COUNCIL FOR SCIENTIFIC AND INDUSTRIAL RESEARCH (CSIR)

- 1. National Treasury acknowledges receipt of your letter dated 10 March 2020.
- 2. The Department requests approval to deviate and appoint CSIR as a single source implementing partner to support the implementation of Cities Support Programme II (CSP II) for a period of three (3) years commencing from date of approval to November 2022 in the amount of R25 000 000.00.
- 3. The request was recommended by the Acting Chief Financial Officer on 10 March 2020.
- 4. The reasons provided to deviate and appoint CSIR are that as an outcome of this intensive planning process for CSP II, it emerged that the CSIR is a significantly stronger implementing partner for the Public Transport and Climate Resilience work planned for CSP II and this will require a larger funding envelope as well as an extension of the MoA timeframe to align with the CSP II three year timeframe. CSIR brings a deep and extensive experience of the metro implementation environment and a large toolbox of models and data that could be immediately applied in the CSP II projects.
- 5. The reasons provided for the deviation are justifiable.
- 6. National Treasury supports the deviation to appoint CSIR for CSP II.
- The Department has an obligation to ensure that any contract for goods and services is in accordance with a system of procurement which is fair, equitable, transparent, competitive and cost effective.
